#### **SYNOPSIS**

Provides certain veteran benefits to veterans of the global war on terror conflicts and those of certain military engagements served during certain periods.

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AN ACT providing certain benefits to veterans of certain conflicts

and amending various parts of the statutory law.

3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. N.J.S.11A:5-1 is amended to read as follows: 8 11A:5-1. As used in this chapter: 9 "Disabled veteran" means any veteran who is eligible to be a. 10 compensated for a service-connected disability from war service by 11 the United States Veterans Administration or who receives or is 12 entitled to receive equivalent compensation for a service-connected 13 disability which arises out of military or naval service as set forth in 14 this chapter and who has submitted sufficient evidence of the record 15 of disability incurred in the line of duty to the Adjutant General of 16 the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs and received a 17 determination of status no later than eight days prior to the issuance 18 of an employment list, for which that individual received a passing

19 score on an examination;

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20 b. "Veteran" means any honorably discharged soldier, sailor, 21 marine or nurse who served in any army or navy of the allies of the 22 United States in World War I, between July 14, 1914 and November 23 11, 1918, or who served in any army or navy of the allies of the 24 United States in World War II, between September 1, 1939 and 25 September 2, 1945 and who was inducted into that service through 26 voluntary enlistment, and was a citizen of the United States at the 27 time of the enlistment, and who did not renounce or lose his or her 28 United States citizenship; or any soldier, sailor, marine, airman, 29 nurse or army field clerk, who has served in the active military or 30 naval service of the United States and has been discharged or 31 released under other than dishonorable conditions from that service [in] rendered during any of the following wars or conflicts and who 32 33 has presented to the Adjutant General of the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs sufficient evidence of the record of service 34 35 and received a determination of status no later than eight days prior 36 to the issuance of an employment list, for which that individual 37 received a passing score on an examination:

38 (1) World War I, between April 6, 1917 and November 11,
39 1918;

40 (2) World War II, on or after September 16, 1940, who shall
41 have served at least 90 days beginning on or before December 31,
42 1946 in such active service, exclusive of any period of assignment
43 for a course of education or training under the Army Specialized
44 Training Program or the Navy College Training Program, which
45 course was a continuation of a civilian course and was pursued to

completion, or as a cadet or midshipman at one of the service
 academies; except that any person receiving an actual service incurred injury or disability shall be classed a veteran whether or
 not that person has completed the 90-day service;

5 (3) Korean conflict, on or after June 23, 1950, who shall have 6 served at least 90 days beginning on or before January 31, 1955, in 7 active service, exclusive of any period of assignment for a course of 8 education or training under the Army Specialized Training Program 9 or the Navy College Training Program, which course was a 10 continuation of a civilian course and was pursued to completion, or 11 as a cadet or midshipman at one of the service academies; except 12 that any person receiving an actual service-incurred injury or 13 disability shall be classed as a veteran, whether or not that person 14 has completed the 90-day service;

15 (4) Lebanon crisis, on or after July 1, 1958, who has served in 16 Lebanon or on board any ship actively engaged in patrolling the 17 territorial waters of that nation for a period, continuous or in the 18 aggregate, of at least 14 days commencing on or before November 19 1, 1958 or the date of termination of that conflict, as proclaimed by 20 the President of the United States or Congress, whichever date of 21 termination is the latest, in such active service; provided, that any 22 person receiving an actual service-incurred injury or disability shall 23 be classed as a veteran whether or not that person has completed the 24 14 days' service as herein provided;

25 (5) Vietnam conflict, on or after December 31, 1960, who shall 26 have served at least 90 days beginning on or before May 7, 1975, in 27 active service, exclusive of any period of assignment for a course of 28 education or training under the Army Specialized Training Program 29 or the Navy College Training Program, which course was a 30 continuation of a civilian course and was pursued to completion, or 31 as a cadet or midshipman at one of the service academies, and 32 exclusive of any service performed pursuant to the provisions of 33 section 511(d) of Title 10, United States Code, or exclusive of any 34 service performed pursuant to enlistment in the National Guard or the Army Reserve, Naval Reserve, Air Force Reserve, Marine 35 36 Corps Reserve, or Coast Guard Reserve; except that any person 37 receiving an actual service-incurred injury or disability shall be 38 classed as a veteran, whether or not that person has completed the 39 90-day service as provided;

40 (6) Lebanon peacekeeping mission, on or after September 26, 41 1982, who has served in Lebanon or on board any ship actively 42 engaged in patrolling the territorial waters of that nation for a 43 period, continuous or in the aggregate, of at least 14 days 44 commencing on or before December 1, 1987 or the date of 45 termination of that mission, as proclaimed by the President of the 46 United States or Congress, whichever date of termination is the 47 latest, in such active service; provided, that any person receiving an 48 actual service-incurred injury or disability shall be classed as a

veteran whether or not that person has completed the 14 days'
 service as herein provided;

3 (7) Grenada peacekeeping mission, on or after October 23, 4 1983, who has served in Grenada or on board any ship actively 5 engaged in patrolling the territorial waters of that nation for a period, continuous or in the aggregate, of at least 14 days 6 7 commencing on or before November 21, 1983 or the date of 8 termination of that mission, as proclaimed by the President of the 9 United States or Congress, whichever date of termination is the 10 latest, in such active service; provided, that any person receiving an 11 actual service-incurred injury or disability shall be classed as a 12 veteran whether or not that person has completed the 14 days' 13 service as herein provided;

(8) Panama peacekeeping mission, on or after December 20, 14 15 1989 or the date of inception of that mission, as proclaimed by the 16 President of the United States or Congress, whichever date of 17 inception is earliest, who has served in Panama or on board any ship 18 actively engaged in patrolling the territorial waters of that nation for 19 a period, continuous or in the aggregate, of at least 14 days 20 commencing on or before January 31, 1990 or the date of 21 termination of that mission, as proclaimed by the President of the 22 United States or Congress, whichever date of termination is the 23 latest, in such active service; provided, that any person receiving an 24 actual service-incurred injury or disability shall be classed as a 25 veteran whether or not that person has completed the 14 days' 26 service as herein provided;

27 (9) Operation "Desert Shield/Desert Storm" mission in the 28 Arabian peninsula and the Persian Gulf, on or after August 2, 1990 29 or the date of inception of that operation, as proclaimed by the 30 President of the United States or Congress, whichever date of 31 inception is earliest, who has served in the Arabian peninsula or on 32 board any ship actively engaged in patrolling the Persian Gulf for a 33 period, continuous or in the aggregate, of at least 14 days 34 commencing on or before the date of termination of that mission, as 35 proclaimed by the President of the United States or Congress, 36 whichever date of termination is the latest, in such active service; 37 provided, that any person receiving an actual service-incurred injury 38 or disability shall be classed as a veteran whether or not that person 39 has completed the 14 days' service as herein provided;

40 (10) Operation Northern Watch and Operation Southern Watch, 41 on or after August 27, 1992, or the date of inception of that 42 operation, as proclaimed by the President of the United States, 43 Congress or United States Secretary of Defense, whichever date of 44 inception is earliest, who served in the theater of operation, 45 including in the Arabian peninsula and the Persian Gulf, and in 46 direct support of that operation for a period, continuously or in the 47 aggregate, of at least 14 days in such active service commencing on 48 or before the date of termination of that operation, as proclaimed by

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the President of the United States, Congress or United States Secretary of Defense, whichever date of termination is the latest; provided, that any person receiving an actual service-incurred injury or disability while engaged in such service shall be classed as a veteran whether or not that person has completed the 14 days' service as herein provided;

Operation "Restore Hope" in Somalia, on or after 7 (11)8 December 5, 1992, or the date of inception of that operation as 9 proclaimed by the President of the United States or the Congress, 10 whichever date is earliest, who has served in Somalia or on board 11 any ship actively engaged in patrolling the territorial waters of that 12 nation for a period, continuously or in the aggregate, of at least 14 13 days in such active service commencing on or before March 31, 14 1994; provided that any person receiving an actual service-incurred 15 injury or disability shall be classed as a veteran whether or not that 16 person has completed the 14-day service as herein provided;

17 Operations "Joint Endeavor" and "Joint Guard" in the (12)Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina, on or after November 20, 18 19 1995, who served in such active service in direct support of one or 20 both of the operations for at least 14 days, continuously or in the 21 aggregate, commencing on or before June 20, 1998, and (1) was 22 deployed in that nation or in another area in the region, or (2) was 23 on board a United States naval vessel operating in the Adriatic Sea, 24 or (3) operated in airspace above the Republic of Bosnia and 25 Herzegovina; provided that any person receiving an actual service-26 incurred injury or disability shall be classed as a veteran whether or 27 not that person completed the 14-day service requirement;

28 Operation "Uphold Democracy" in Haiti, on or after (13)29 September 19, 1994, who served in Haiti or on board any ship 30 actively engaged in patrolling the territorial waters of that nation for 31 a period, continuously or in the aggregate, of at least 14 days in 32 such active service commencing on or before March 31, 1995, and 33 who received an Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal for such 34 service; provided, that any person receiving an actual service-35 incurred injury or disability shall be classed as a veteran whether or 36 not that person has completed the 14 days' service as herein 37 provided or received an Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal;

38 (14) Operation "Enduring Freedom", on or after September 11, 39 2001, who served in a theater of operation and in direct support of 40 that operation for a period, continuously or in the aggregate, of at 41 least 14 days in such active service commencing on or before the 42 date the President of the United States or the United States 43 Secretary of Defense designates as the termination date of that 44 operation; provided, that any person receiving an actual service-45 incurred injury or disability while engaged in such service shall be classed as a veteran whether or not that person has completed the 14 46 47 days' service as herein provided; [and]

48 (15) Operation "Iraqi Freedom", on or after the date the

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1 President of the United States or the United States Secretary of 2 Defense designates as the inception date of that operation, who 3 served in Iraq or in another area in the region in direct support of that operation for a period, continuously or in the aggregate, of at 4 5 least 14 days in such active service commencing on or before the date the President of the United States or the United States 6 7 Secretary of Defense designates as the termination date of that 8 operation; provided, that any person receiving an actual service-9 incurred injury or disability while engaged in such service shall be 10 classed as a veteran whether or not that person has completed the 14 11 days' service as herein provided; and

12 (16) Operation, mission or conflict during the global war on 13 terror, on or after the date the President of the United States or the 14 United States Secretary of Defense designates as the inception date 15 of that operation, mission or conflict for a period, continuously or in 16 the aggregate, of at least 14 days in such active service, 17 commencing on or before the date the President of the United 18 States or the United States Secretary of Defense shall designate as 19 the termination date of that operation, mission or conflict, who 20 served in the theater or in support of that operation, mission, or 21 conflict, in the United States or abroad; provided, that any person 22 receiving an actual service-incurred injury or disability while 23 engaged in such service shall be classed as a veteran whether or not 24 that person has completed the 14 days' service as herein provided;

25 c. "Veteran" also means any honorably discharged member who has served at least 90 days commencing between the dates of 26 the wars or conflicts in paragraphs 4 and 6-16 inclusive of 27 28 subsection b. of this section, regardless of location, exclusive of any 29 period (a) of assignment for a course of education or training which 30 course was a continuation of a civilian course and was pursued to 31 completion, or (b) as a cadet or midshipman at one of the service 32 academies, or (c) of service performed pursuant to an enlistment in 33 the Army National Guard or Air National Guard or in the Army 34 Reserve, Naval Reserve, Air Force Reserve, Marine Corps Reserve, 35 or Coast Guard Reserve, unless mobilized for active duty at the call 36 of the President of the United States, provided, that any person 37 receiving an actual, service-incurred injury or disability shall be 38 classed as a veteran, whether or not he has completed the 90 days' 39 service as herein provided;

40 [c.] d. "War service" means service by a veteran in any war or
41 conflict described in this chapter during the periods specified.
42 (cf: P.L.2007, c.115, s.1)

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44 2. N.J.S.18A:66-2 is amended to read as follows:

45 18A:66-2. As used in this article:

a. "Accumulated deductions" means the sum of all the
amounts, deducted from the compensation of a member or
contributed by or in behalf of the member, including interest

credited to January 1, 1956, standing to the credit of the member's
 individual account in the annuity savings fund.

b. "Annuity" means payments for life derived from theaccumulated deductions of a member as provided in this article.

5 c. "Beneficiary" means any person receiving a retirement 6 allowance or other benefit as provided in this article.

7 d. (1) "Compensation" means the contractual salary, for 8 services as a teacher as defined in this article, which is in 9 accordance with established salary policies of the member's 10 employer for all employees in the same position but shall not 11 include individual salary adjustments which are granted primarily in anticipation of the member's retirement or additional remuneration 12 for performing temporary or extracurricular duties beyond the 13 14 regular school day or the regular school year.

15 (2) In the case of a person who becomes a member of the 16 retirement system on or after July 1, 2007, "compensation" means 17 the amount of the contractual salary equivalent to the annual 18 maximum wage contribution base for Social Security, pursuant to 19 the Federal Insurance Contributions Act, for services as a teacher as 20 defined in this article, which is in accordance with established salary policies of the member's employer for all employees in the 21 22 same position but shall not include individual salary adjustments 23 which are granted primarily in anticipation of the member's 24 retirement or additional remuneration for performing temporary or 25 extracurricular duties beyond the regular school day or the regular 26 school year. This paragraph shall not apply to a person who at the 27 time of enrollment in the retirement system on or after July 1, 2007 transfers service credit from another State-administered retirement 28 29 system pursuant to N.J.S.18A:66-15.1, but shall apply to a former 30 member of the retirement system who has been granted a retirement 31 allowance and is reenrolled in the retirement system on or after July 1, 2007 pursuant to N.J.S.18A:66-53.2 after becoming employed 32 33 again in a position that makes the person eligible to be a member of 34 the retirement system.

For the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2011, "contractual salary" for State employees shall include wage increases under a collective negotiations agreement notwithstanding that, by amendment to that collective negotiations agreement, the effective date of the contractual increase has been deferred. For the purpose of this paragraph, "State employee" means an employee in the Executive Branch of State government of New Jersey.

42 e. "Employer" means the State, the board of education or any
43 educational institution or agency of or within the State by which a
44 teacher is paid.

f. (1) "Final compensation" means the average annual
compensation for which contributions are made for the three years
of creditable service in New Jersey immediately preceding the
member's retirement or death, or it shall mean the average annual

compensation for New Jersey service for which contributions are
 made during any three fiscal years of his or her membership
 providing the largest possible benefit to the member or the
 member's beneficiary.

5 (2) In the case of a person who becomes a member of the 6 retirement system on or after the effective date of P.L.2010, c.1, 7 "final compensation" means the average annual compensation for 8 which contributions are made for the five years of creditable service 9 in New Jersey immediately preceding the member's retirement or 10 death, or it shall mean the average annual compensation for New 11 Jersey service for which contributions are made during any five 12 fiscal years of his or her membership providing the largest possible benefit to the member or the member's beneficiary. 13

g. "Fiscal year" means any year commencing with July 1, andending with June 30, next following.

h. "Pension" means payments for life derived from
appropriations made by the State or employers to the Teachers'
Pension and Annuity Fund.

i. "Annuity reserve" means the present value of all payments
to be made on account of any annuity or benefit in lieu of an
annuity, granted under the provisions of this article, computed on
the basis of such mortality tables recommended by the actuary as
the board of trustees adopts, with regular interest.

j. "Pension reserve" means the present value of all payments to
be made on account of any pension or benefit in lieu of a pension
granted to a member from the Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund,
computed on the basis of such mortality tables recommended by the
actuary as the board of trustees adopts, with regular interest.

k. "Present-entrant" means any member of the Teachers'
Pension and Annuity Fund who had established status as a "presententrant member" of said fund prior to January 1, 1956.

32 l. "Rate of contribution initially certified" means the rate of
33 contribution certified by the retirement system in accordance with
34 N.J.S.18A:66-29.

35 m. "Regular interest" shall mean interest as determined by the 36 State Treasurer, after consultation with the Directors of the 37 Divisions of Investment and Pensions, the board of trustees and the actuary. It shall bear a reasonable relationship to the percentage rate 38 39 of earnings on investments based on the market value of assets but 40 shall not exceed the assumed percentage rate of increase applied to 41 salaries plus 3%, provided however that the board of trustees shall 42 not set the average percentage rate of increase applied to salaries 43 below 6%.

n. "Retirement allowance" means the pension plus the annuity.

45 o. "School service" means any service as a "teacher" as defined46 in this section.

p. "Teacher" means any regular teacher, special teacher,helping teacher, teacher clerk, principal, vice-principal, supervisor,

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1 supervising principal, director, superintendent, city superintendent, assistant city superintendent, county superintendent, 2 State 3 Commissioner or Assistant Commissioner of Education, members 4 of the State Department of Education who are certificated, 5 unclassified professional staff and other members of the teaching or 6 professional staff of any class, public school, high school, normal 7 school, model school, training school, vocational school, truant 8 reformatory school, or parental school, and of any and all classes or 9 schools within the State conducted under the order and 10 superintendence, and wholly or partly at the expense of the State 11 Board of Education, of a duly elected or appointed board of 12 education, board of school directors, or board of trustees of the 13 State or of any school district or normal school district thereof, and 14 any persons under contract or engagement to perform one or more 15 of these functions. It shall also mean any person who serves, while 16 on an approved leave of absence from regular duties as a teacher, as 17 an officer of a local, county or State labor organization which 18 represents, or is affiliated with an organization which represents, 19 teachers as defined in this subsection. No person shall be deemed a 20 teacher within the meaning of this article who is a substitute 21 teacher. In all cases of doubt the board of trustees shall determine 22 whether any person is a teacher as defined in this article.

23 "Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund," hereinafter referred q. 24 to as the "retirement system" or "system," is the corporate name of 25 the arrangement for the payment of retirement allowances and other 26 benefits under the provisions of this article, including the several 27 funds placed under said system. By that name all its business shall 28 be transacted, its funds invested, warrants for money drawn, and 29 payments made and all of its cash and securities and other property 30 held.

31 "Veteran" means any honorably discharged officer, soldier, r. 32 sailor, airman, marine or nurse who served in any Army, Air Force 33 or Navy of the Allies of the United States in World War I between 34 July 14, 1914, and November 11, 1918, or who served in any Army, 35 Air Force or Navy of the Allies of the United States in World War 36 II, between September 1, 1939, and September 2, 1945, and who 37 was inducted into such service through voluntary enlistment, and 38 was a citizen of the United States at the time of such enlistment, and 39 who did not, during or by reason of such service, renounce or lose 40 United States citizenship, and any officer, soldier, sailor, marine, 41 airman, nurse or army field clerk who has served in the active 42 military or naval service of the United States and has or shall be 43 discharged or released [therefrom] under conditions other than 44 dishonorable, [in] from that service rendered during any of the 45 following wars, uprisings, insurrections, expeditions or 46 emergencies, and who has presented to the retirement system 47 evidence of such record of service in form and content satisfactory 48 to said retirement system:

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(1) The Indian wars and uprisings during any of the periods
 recognized by the War Department of the United States as periods
 of active hostility;

4 (2) The Spanish-American War between April 20, 1898, and 5 April 11, 1899;

6 (3) The Philippine insurrections and expeditions during the
7 periods recognized by the War Department of the United States as
8 of active hostility from February 4, 1899, to the end of 1913;

9 (4) The Peking relief expedition between June 20, 1900, and 10 May 27, 1902;

(5) The army of Cuban occupation between July 18, 1898, andMay 20, 1902;

13 (6) The army of Cuban pacification between October 6, 1906,14 and April 1, 1909;

(7) The Mexican punitive expedition between March 14, 1916,and February 7, 1917;

17 (8) The Mexican border patrol, having actually participated in
18 engagements against Mexicans between April 12, 1911, and June
19 16, 1919;

20 (9) World War I, between April 6, 1917, and November 11,
21 1918;

22 (10) World War II, between September 16, 1940, and December 23 31, 1946, who shall have served at least 90 days in such active 24 service, exclusive of any period of assignment (1) for a course of 25 education or training under the Army Specialized Training Program 26 or the Navy College Training Program, which course was a 27 continuation of a civilian course and was pursued to completion, or 28 (2) as a cadet or midshipman at one of the service academies, any 29 part of which 90 days was served between said dates; provided that 30 any person receiving an actual service-incurred injury or disability 31 shall be classed as a veteran, whether or not that person has 32 completed the 90-day service as herein provided;

33 (11) Korean conflict on or after June 23, 1950, and on or prior to 34 January 31, 1955, who shall have served at least 90 days in such 35 active service, exclusive of any period of assignment (1) for a course of education or training under the Army Specialized 36 37 Training Program or the Navy College Training Program, which 38 course was a continuation of a civilian course and was pursued to 39 completion, or (2) as a cadet or midshipman at one of the service 40 academies, any part of which 90 days was served between said 41 dates; provided that any person receiving an actual service-incurred 42 injury or disability shall be classed as a veteran, whether or not that 43 person has completed the 90-day service as herein provided; and 44 provided further that any member classed as a veteran pursuant to 45 this subsection prior to August 1, 1966, shall continue to be classed 46 as a veteran, whether or not that person completed the 90-day 47 service between said dates as herein provided;

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1 (12) Lebanon crisis, on or after July 1, 1958, who has served in 2 Lebanon or on board any ship actively engaged in patrolling the 3 territorial waters of that nation for a period, continuous or in the 4 aggregate, of at least 14 days commencing on or before November 5 1, 1958 or the date of termination of that conflict, as proclaimed by 6 the President of the United States or Congress, whichever date of 7 termination is the latest, in such active service; provided, that any 8 person receiving an actual service-incurred injury or disability shall 9 be classed as a veteran whether or not that person has completed the 10 14 days' service as herein provided;

11 (13) Vietnam conflict, on or after December 31, 1960, and on or 12 prior to May 7, 1975, who shall have served at least 90 days in such active service, exclusive of any period of assignment (1) for a 13 14 course of education or training under the Army Specialized 15 Training Program or the Navy College Training Program, which 16 course was a continuation of a civilian course and was pursued to 17 completion, or (2) as a cadet or midshipman at one of the service 18 academies, any part of which 90 days was served between said 19 dates; and exclusive of any service performed pursuant to the 20 provisions of section 511(d) of Title 10, United States Code, 21 pursuant to an enlistment in the Army National Guard or as a 22 reserve for service in the Army Reserve, Naval Reserve, Air Force 23 Reserve, Marine Corps Reserve, or Coast Guard Reserve; provided 24 that any person receiving an actual service-incurred injury or 25 disability shall be classed as a veteran, whether or not that person 26 has completed the 90-day service as herein provided;

27 (14) Lebanon peacekeeping mission, on or after September 26, 28 1982, who has served in Lebanon or on board any ship actively 29 engaged in patrolling the territorial waters of that nation for a 30 period, continuous or in the aggregate, of at least 14 days 31 commencing on or before December 1, 1987 or the date of 32 termination of that mission, as proclaimed by the President of the 33 United States or Congress, whichever date of termination is the 34 latest, in such active service; provided, that any person receiving an 35 actual service-incurred injury or disability shall be classed as a 36 veteran whether or not that person has completed the 14 days' 37 service as herein provided;

38 (15) Grenada peacekeeping mission, on or after October 23, 39 1983, who has served in Grenada or on board any ship actively 40 engaged in patrolling the territorial waters of that nation for a 41 period, continuous or in the aggregate, of at least 14 days 42 commencing on or before November 21, 1983 or the date of 43 termination of that mission, as proclaimed by the President of the 44 United States or Congress, whichever date of termination is the 45 latest, in such active service; provided, that any person receiving an 46 actual service-incurred injury or disability shall be classed as a 47 veteran whether or not that person has completed the 14 days' 48 service as herein provided;

World War II, September 16, 1940 to December 31, 1946;
World War I, April 6, 1917 to November 11, 1918, and in the case
of service with the United States military forces in Russia, April 6,

Spanish-American War, April 21, 1898 to August 13, 1898;
Civil War, April 15, 1861 to May 26, 1865; or, as to any
subsequent war, during the period from the date of declaration of war
to the date on which actual hostilities shall cease.

(b) "Assessor" means the assessor, board of assessors or any other
official or body of a taxing district charged with the duty of assessing
real and personal property for the purpose of general taxation.

(d) "Honorably discharged or released under honorable
circumstances from active service in time of war," means and includes
every form of separation from active, full-time duty with military or

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1 naval pay and allowances in some branch of the Armed Forces of the 2 United States in time of war, other than those marked "dishonorable," 3 "undesirable," "bad conduct," "by sentence of general court martial," "by sentence of summary court martial" or similar expression 4 5 indicating that the discharge or release was not under honorable 6 circumstances. A disenrollment certificate or other form of release 7 terminating temporary service in a military or naval branch of the armed forces rendered on a voluntary and part-time basis without pay, 8 9 or a release from or deferment of induction into the active military or naval service shall not be deemed to be included in the aforementioned 10 11 phrase.

(e) "Pre-tax year" means the particular calendar year immediatelypreceding the "tax year."

(f) "Resident" means one legally domiciled within the State of
New Jersey. Mere seasonal or temporary residence within the State, of
whatever duration, shall not constitute domicile within the State for the
purposes of this act. Absence from this State for a period of 12
months shall be prima facie evidence of abandonment of domicile in
this State. The burden of establishing legal domicile within the State

23 (h) "Veteran" means any citizen and resident of this State 24 honorably discharged or released under honorable circumstances from 25 active service in time of war in any branch of the Armed Forces of the 26 United States. (j) "Surviving spouse" means the surviving wife or husband of
any of the following, while he or she is a resident of this State, during
widowhood or widowerhood:

46 1. A citizen and resident of this State who has died or shall die
47 while on active duty in time of war in any branch of the Armed Forces
48 of the United States; or

A citizen and resident of this State who has had or shall
 hereafter have active service in time of war in any branch of the

(1) "Mutual housing corporation" means a corporation not-forprofit incorporated under the laws of New Jersey on a mutual or
cooperative basis within the scope of section 607 of the "National
Defense Housing Act," Pub.L.76-849 (42 U.S.C.s.1521 et seq.), which
acquired a National Defense Housing Project pursuant to that act.

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6. This act shall take effect immediately, and section 1 shall apply to eligible lists prepared on or after the effective date and section 5 shall apply to the tax year next following enactment.

STATEMENT

This bill provides veterans status to a veteran of any operation, mission or conflict during the global war on terror, including those who served in Operation Noble Eagle, in the United States or abroad.

Under current law, only members of Operations Enduring and
Iraqi Freedom are veterans of the global war on terror. Under
current law, members of Noble Eagle or any other concurrent or
subsequent operation, mission or conflict related to the global war
on terror do not qualify. This bill will include those persons.

This bill amends several statutes that define "veteran" for the purposes of civil service hiring preferences, the purchase of service credit and the calculation of retirant benefits in the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) and Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund (TPAF), for the purchase of service credit in the Police and Firemen's Retirement System (PFRS), and for the receipt of a property tax deduction or exemption.

Also, under this bill, the "in country" 14-day active service
requirement that limits the definition of veteran for some military
engagements is supplemented with a minimum 90-day active
military service requirement regardless of location, exclusive of any
period (1) of assignment for a course of education or training which

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1 course was a continuation of a civilian course and was pursued to 2 completion, or (2) as a cadet or midshipman at one of the service 3 academies, or (3) of service performed pursuant to an enlistment in 4 the Army National Guard or Air National Guard or in the Army 5 Reserve, Naval Reserve, Air Force Reserve, Marine Corps Reserve, 6 or Coast Guard Reserve, unless mobilized for active duty at the call 7 of the President of the United States, provided, that any person 8 receiving an actual, service-incurred injury or disability will be 9 classed as a veteran, whether or not he has completed the 90 days' service as herein provided. Consequently, active military service 10 11 for at least 90 days performed anywhere, in whole or in part, during 12 the dates for the specific engagements named will qualify a person 13 as a "veteran" for the purposes of the statutes amended. Thus, the 14 bill will permit a greater number of individuals to receive the 15 benefits specified.
