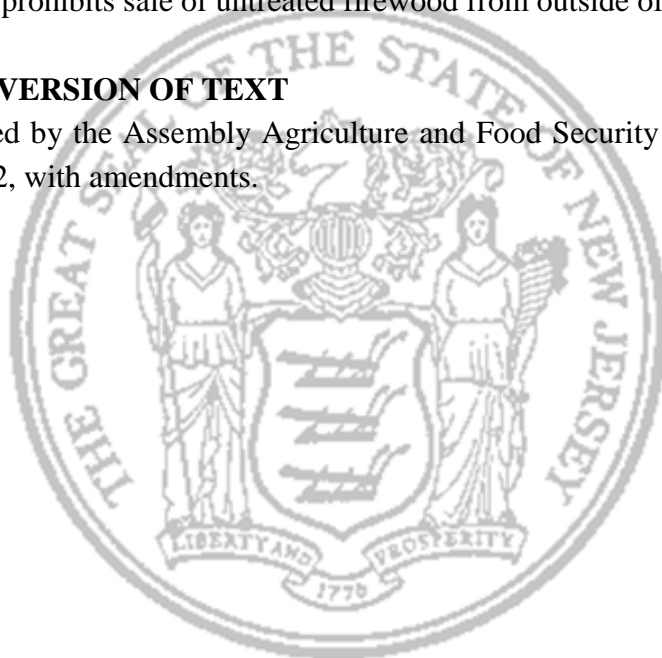

**SYNOPSIS**

Provides that farm, farmstand, or other agricultural operation selling firewood obtained from property other than seller's shall not be considered lumber yard; prohibits sale of untreated firewood from outside of State.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. <sup>1</sup>a.<sup>1</sup> Any farmstand or location on a farm, or location used  
8 by a farm or other agricultural operation, to sell firewood obtained  
9 from property other than the seller's land shall not be considered a  
10 lumber yard under municipal land use regulations or for other  
11 regulatory purposes.

12 <sup>1</sup>b. Any firewood obtained from outside of the State shall not be  
13 sold or offered for sale at any farmstand or location on a farm, or  
14 location used by a farm or other agricultural operation, in the State  
15 unless it is heat treated and certified as heat treated and pest free by  
16 the state of origin of the firewood.<sup>1</sup>

18 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
