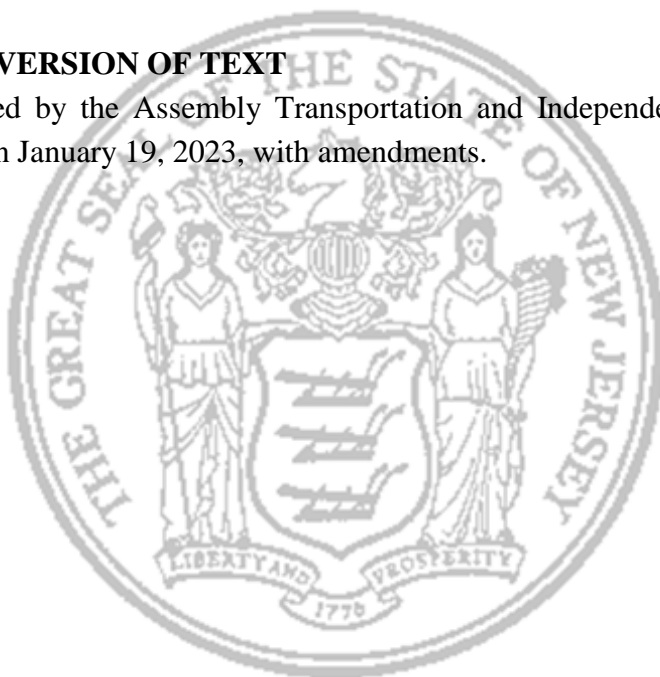

Requires publication of certain information related to toll discounts on E-ZPass website.

1 AN ACT concerning certain information related to toll rate discounts  
2 and supplementing P.L.1997, c.59 (C.27:12B-18.2 et al.).

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. The lead agency of the New Jersey E-ZPass Group shall  
8 <sup>1</sup>**[.]** on every publicly accessible <sup>1</sup>**[webpage of a]** website in  
9 which the lead agency provides information concerning the  
10 purchase of an electronic vehicle identification system transponder  
11 or the initiation of an account with a New Jersey electronic toll  
12 collection system, subject to sections 6 through 10 of P.L.1997,  
13 c.59 (C.27:23-34.1 through C.27:23-34.5) or sections 11 through 15  
14 of P.L.1997, c.59 (C.27:25A-21.1 through C.27:25A-21.5), publish  
15 information that notifies customers and prospective customers that  
16 discounts on toll rates advertised by an operator of an electronic toll  
17 collection system not under the jurisdiction of the State, any agency  
18 or authority of the State, or any political subdivisions thereof, may  
19 not be applicable to an account with a New Jersey electronic toll  
20 collection system subject to sections 6 through 10 of P.L.1997, c.59  
21 (C.27:23-34.1 through C.27:23-34.5) or sections 11 through 15 of  
22 P.L.1997, c.59 (C.27:25A-21.1 through C.27:25A-21.5).

23 As used in this section, “lead agency of the New Jersey E-ZPass  
24 Group” or “lead agency” means an agency, authority, or political  
25 subdivision of this State which has the authority to enter into,  
26 manage, or negotiate contracts to provide service to accounts with a  
27 New Jersey electronic toll collection system subject to sections 6  
28 through 10 of P.L.1997, c.59 (C.27:23-34.1 through C.27:23-34.5)  
29 or sections 11 through 15 of P.L.1997, c.59 (C.27:25A-21.1 through  
30 C.27:25A-21.5).

32 2. This act shall take effect on the 30th day following  
33 enactment.
