license plates. The ¹ [Rowan University] alumni license plates shall be subject to the provisions of chapter 3 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes, except as hereinafter otherwise provided.

- b. Application for issuance of ¹[Rowan University]¹ alumni 4 license plates shall be made to the chief administrator on forms and 5 in a manner prescribed by the chief administrator. In order to be 6 7 deemed complete, an application shall be accompanied by a fee of 8 \$50, payable to the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, which 9 shall be in addition to the fees otherwise prescribed by law for the 10 registration of a motor vehicle. The chief administrator shall collect annually, subsequent to the year of issuance of the ¹[Rowan 11 University 1 alumni license plates, a \$10 fee for the license plates 12 in addition to the fees otherwise prescribed by law for the 13 14 registration of a motor vehicle. The additional fees required by this subsection shall be deposited in ¹[the "Rowan University License 15 16 Plate Fund" the special non-lapsing fund created ', pursuant to subsection c. of this section 1, for the alumni license plate 17 program¹. 18

- d. Prior to the deposit of the additional fees collected pursuant to subsection b. of this section into ¹ [the "Rowan University License Plate Fund,"] the applicable special non-lapsing fund, ¹ amounts thereof as are necessary shall be used to reimburse the

commission for all costs reasonably and actually incurred, as stipulated by the chief administrator for:

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- (1) designing, producing, issuing, renewing, and publicizing the availability of ¹[the Rowan University] ¹ alumni license plates; and
- (2) any computer programming changes that may be initially necessary to implement ¹[the Rowan University] each ¹ alumni license plate program in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.

The chief administrator shall annually certify to the State Treasurer the average cost per license plate incurred in the immediately preceding year by the commission in producing, issuing, renewing, and publicizing the availability of ¹[the Rowan University 1 alumni license plates for each alumni license plate program¹. The annual certification of the average cost per license plate shall be approved by the Joint Budget Oversight Committee¹[,]¹ or its successor.

In the event that the average cost per license plate ¹under any alumni license plate program. ¹ as certified by the chief administrator and approved by the Joint Budget Oversight Committee ¹[,] ¹ or its successor, is greater than the \$50 application fee established in subsection b. of this section in two consecutive fiscal years, the chief administrator may discontinue the issuance of ¹[Rowan University] the ¹ alumni license plates.

- e. The chief administrator shall notify eligible motorists of the opportunity to obtain ¹[Rowan University] ¹ alumni license plates by publicizing the availability of the license plates on the commission's website. The ¹[Rowan University Alumni Association President] director of an alumni association of a four-year public institution of higher education ¹ and any other individual or entity designated by ¹[the Rowan University Alumni Association] an alumni association ¹, may publicize the availability of ¹[the Rowan University] ¹ alumni license plates in any manner that ¹[the Rowan University Alumni Association] the alumni association ¹ deems appropriate.

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¹[3.] <u>5.</u>¹ This act shall take effect immediately ¹[, but shall remain inoperative until the first day of the 13th month following the date on which the conditions set forth in paragraphs (1) and (2) of subsection c. of section 2 of this act have been satisfied. The chief administrator may take anticipatory acts in advance of that date as may be necessary for the timely implementation of this act. This act shall expire if the conditions set forth in paragraphs (1) and (2) of subsection c. of section 2 of this act are not satisfied by the last day of the 15th month following enactment]¹.
