AN ACT concerning education required for the Animal Health 1 2 Technician job title in the civil service and supplementing Title 3 11A of the New Jersey Statues. 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 1. a. The required number of specific credit hours in veterinary 9 science/technology, animal science technology, zoology, biology, animal husbandry, or related fields at an accredited college or 10 university shall be no greater than 12 hours for any job title of 11 12 Animal Health Technician within the civil service ¹local title 13 listing¹. b. An applicant with five years of experience in 1 [the 14 veterinary technician field in a veterinary hospital, veterinary 15 16 practice, humane society or other similar place of work where animals are cared for or kept], a veterinary office, animal hospital, 17 18 animal shelter, or other similar place of work where animals are cared for or kept performing vaccinations, diagnostic tests, 19 euthanasia, or various other medical treatments on animals or work 20 involving animal nutrition, taxonomy, animal behavior, 21 22 parasitology, or bacteriology¹ and who does not meet all of the 23 education requirements shall be eligible for the Animal Health Technician job title ¹within the civil service local title listing¹. 24 25 26 2. This act shall take effect ¹[immediately] <u>on the first day of</u> the seventh month following the date of enactment¹. 27
