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AN ACT concerning services provided by the New Jersey Motor

 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
 of New Jersey:

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8 1. The New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission shall maintain a telephone call center ¹located within the State¹ where commission 9 employees, or persons under contract with the commission, are 10 available in real-time, at a minimum, during weekdays between 11 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., to assist individuals in navigating the 12 commission's Internet website and processing online transactions. 13 14 The commission shall provide telephone call center services in both English and Spanish. ¹The commission may provide additional 15 web-based tutorial support and recorded help messages, in order to 16 reduce total call center staffing needs.¹ 17

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19 2. The New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission shall collect
20 and make available on its Internet website quarterly performance
21 metric reports of the telephone call center. The reports shall
22 include, but not be limited to, information pertaining to the number
23 of calls, the length of individual wait times, the call purpose, and
24 the length of calls.

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26 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
