#### **SYNOPSIS**

Provides temporary one-year extension of service life of school buses for 2022-2023 school year; authorizes chief administrator to allow one-year extension in subsequent two school years.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

For <sup>1</sup>[the 2022-2023 school year, the retirement date of school buses provided by <u>a school bus used for pupil</u> 8 transportation purposes in the 2021-2022 school year that would 9 otherwise be required to be retired in 2022 pursuant to<sup>1</sup> section 1 of 10 P.L.1983, c.206 (C.39:3B-5.1) and section 2 of P.L.1983, c.206 11 (C.39:3B-5.2)<sup>1</sup>, the Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor 12 <u>Vehicle Commission</u><sup>1</sup> shall <sup>1</sup>[be extended] <u>extend the retirement</u> 13 14 date of such school bus<sup>1</sup> by one year <sup>1</sup>upon request by the owner of the school bus<sup>1</sup>. 15

b. <sup>1</sup>[For the 2023-2024 school year and the 2024-2025 school 16 year, the] The<sup>1</sup> Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor 17 Vehicle Commission, in consultation with the Commissioner of 18 19 Education, may<sup>1</sup>, upon request by the owner of the school bus,<sup>1</sup> allow an additional year of service for any school bus used for pupil 20 transportation purposes in the prior school year that would 21 otherwise be required to be retired <sup>1</sup>in 2023 or 2024<sup>1</sup> pursuant to 22 section 1 of P.L.1983, c.206 (C.39:3B-5.1) and section 2 of 23 24 P.L.1983, c.206 (C.39:3B-5.2), provided any inspections of the 25 school bus determine that the school bus may safely be used for pupil transportation. <sup>1</sup><u>The chief administrator shall not grant a</u> 26 school bus more than one extension pursuant to this act.<sup>1</sup> 27

c. In any year that school buses are allowed to be operated beyond the statutory service life provided in section 1 of P.L.1983, c.206 (C.39:3B-5.1) and section 2 of P.L.1983, c.206 (C.39:3B-5.2), the chief administrator shall provide a report to the Governor and, pursuant to section 2 of P.L.1991, c.164 (C.52:14-19.1), the Legislature that contains the following information:

(1) the number of school buses in each school district in the
State authorized to operate beyond the statutory service life
provided by section 1 of P.L.1983, c.206 (C.39:3B-5.1) and section
2 of P.L.1983, c.206 (C.39:3B-5.2);

(3) any data or information that the chief administrator used to
