The board of education of every school district shall 9 cause an annual audit of the district's accounts and financial 10 transactions to be made by a public school accountant employed by 11 it, which audit shall be completed not later than [5 months after] the January 31 next following the end of the school fiscal year. 12 13 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, or of any law, rule, 14 or regulation to the contrary, the board of education of every school 15 district shall submit the Audit Summary to the commissioner not 16 later than the January 15 next following the end of the school fiscal 17 year. 18 (cf:P.L.2010, c.49, s.1)]¹ 19 20 ¹[2. Notwithstanding the provisions of N.J.S.18A:23-1 or of 34 any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, the board of education of every school district shall complete the annual audit of the 35 36 district's accounts and financial transactions required pursuant to 37 N.J.S.18A:23-1 for the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years not later than the January 10 next following the end of the school fiscal 38 39 year, and the board of education of every school shall submit the 40 Audit Summary to the Commissioner of Education not later than the 41 January 1 next following the end of the school fiscal year.
