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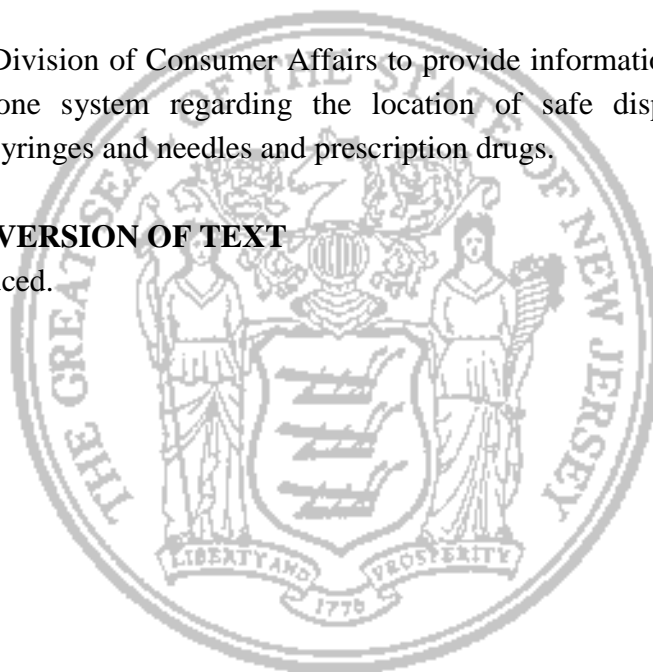

Requires Division of Consumer Affairs to provide information to Statewide 2-1-1 telephone system regarding the location of safe disposal sites for hypodermic syringes and needles and prescription drugs.

2 prescription drugs and medication, and supplementing Title 45 of
3 the Revised Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

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8 1. The Division of Consumer Affairs in the Department of Law
9 and Public Safety shall periodically provide the Statewide 2-1-1
10 telephone system with information regarding the location of safe
11 disposal sites for hypodermic syringes and needles and prescription
12 drugs and medication for dissemination to customers of the
13 Statewide 2-1-1 telephone system upon customers' request.

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15 2. This act shall take effect 180 days after the date of
16 enactment.

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STATEMENT

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21 The Division of Consumer Affairs in the Department of Law and
22 Public Safety is to periodically provide the Statewide 2-1-1
23 telephone system with information regarding the location of safe
24 disposal sites for hypodermic syringes and needles and prescription
25 drugs and medication for dissemination to customers of the
