#### **SYNOPSIS**

Provides one-year waiver of certain MVC fees imposed for driver's licenses and non-driver identification cards.

#### A4401 JAFFER, MORIARTY

1 AN ACT concerning fees for driver's licenses and non-driver identifications.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. a. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, including, but not limited to, R.S.39:3-10, section 4 of P.L.2001, c.391 (C.39:3-10f4), section 22 of P.L.1990, c.103 (C.39:3-10.30), and sections 4 and 6 of P.L.1980, c.47 (C.39:3-29.5 and C.39:3-29.7), during the period beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023, the Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission shall waive the payment of fees

14 for:

- 15 (1) the renewal of a non-driver identification card pursuant to 16 section 4 of P.L.1980, c.47 (C.39:3-29.5);
- 17 (2) the renewal of a commercial driver license pursuant to P.L.1999, c.103 (C.39:3-10.9 et al.);
- 19 (3) the renewal of a motorcycle license or endorsement pursuant 20 to R.S.39:3-10;
  - (4) the renewal of a basic driver's license pursuant to R.S.39:3-10; and
  - (5) the digitized photographs required for the issuance and renewal of each license or non-driver identification card.
  - b. During the period beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023:
  - (1) the required fee shall be \$11 to upgrade a standard basic driver's license or standard non-driver identification card to a REAL ID basic driver's license or REAL ID non-driver identification card;
  - (2) the required fee for the initial issuance of a REAL ID basic driver's license shall be the amount set forth in subsection m. of R.S.39:3-10 and the amount set forth in section 4 of P.L.2001, c.391 (C.39:3-10f4) for a digitized photograph, except as these amounts may be adjusted pursuant to section 16 of P.L.2007, c.335 (C.39:2A-36.1); and
  - (3) the required fee for the initial issuance of a REAL ID non-driver identification card shall be the amounts set forth in section 6 of P.L.1980, c.47 (C.39:3-29.7) for the REAL ID non-driver identification card and the digitized photograph, except as these amounts may be adjusted pursuant to section 16 of P.L.2007, c.335 (C.39:2A-36.1).

2. This act shall take effect on October 1, 2022 and shall expire on September 30, 2023, except the Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission may take such anticipatory administrative action in advance as shall be necessary for the implementation of this act.

This bill provides for a one-year waiver of certain fees imposed by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC) related to driver's licenses and non-driver identification cards.

Specifically, the bill provides that during the period beginning 6 7 October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2022, the MVC would 8 not impose fees for: (1) the renewal of a non-driver identification 9 card; (2) the renewal of a commercial driver license; (3) the renewal 10 of a motorcycle license or endorsement; (4) the renewal of a basic 11 driver's license; and (5) the digitized photographs required for the 12 issuance and renewal of each license or non-driver identification card. During this period, the fee imposed for upgrading a standard 13 14 basic driver's license or non-driver identification card to a REAL 15 ID basic driver's license or non-driver identification card would be 16 reduced to \$11. However, the bill would not reduce the fees 17 imposed for the initial issuance of a REAL ID basic driver's license 18 or non-driver identification card.

As part of the proposed Fiscal Year 2023 Budget, the Governor recommended a one-year waiver of the imposition of renewal fees for driver's licenses and non-driver identification cards. This bill is intended to effectuate this recommendation.
