1 AN ACT concerning certain road projects and supplementing Title
2 27 of the Revised Statutes.

4 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. a. The Commissioner of Transportation shall consider and
8 evaluate the feasibility of installing traffic circles for each
9 construction or improvement project of a road under the jurisdiction
10 of the Department of Transportation or under the jurisdiction of a
11 county that involves one or more intersections.

12 b. The evaluation of the feasibility of installing traffic circles
13 pursuant to subsection a. of this section shall be made by the
14 commissioner, in conjunction with the appropriate highway and
15 road planning authorities, engineers, departments, and
16 administrative offices.

18 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

22

23 This bill requires the Commissioner of Transportation to
24 consider and evaluate the feasibility of installing traffic circles on
25 county and State roads. The bill requires that this consideration be
26 made for every county and State road construction or improvement
27 project that involves one or more intersections. The evaluation of
28 the feasibility of installing traffic circles is required to be made in
29 conjunction with various planning authorities, engineers,
30 departments, and administrative offices.
