1 AN ACT concerning menopause and supplementing Title 26 of the
2 Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. a. Commencing 180 days following the effective date of this
8 act, a licensed health care professional who performs an annual
9 physical examination on a female patient who is 40 years of age or
10 older shall provide the female patient an informational pamphlet on
11 perimenopause, menopause, and post-menopause, as prepared and
12 published by the Department of Health pursuant to subsection b. of
13 this section, during the visit.

14 b. Within 90 days following the effective date of this act, the
15 Department of Health shall prepare and publish on its Internet
16 website an informational pamphlet on perimenopause, menopause,
17 and post-menopause, in order to effectuate the purposes of this act.

19 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

24 This bill requires menopause information to be distributed under
25 certain circumstances.

26 Under the bill, commencing 180 days following the bill's
27 effective date, a licensed health care professional who performs an
28 annual physical examination on a female patient who is 40 years of
29 age or older is to provide the female patient an informational
30 pamphlet on perimenopause, menopause, and post-menopause, as
31 prepared and published by the Department of Health pursuant to the
32 bill, during the visit.
