1 AN ACT concerning employee access to employment records, and 2 supplementing Title 34 of the Revised Statutes. 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 1. a. <sup>1</sup>[Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S.43:21-11 et seq., or 7 any other law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Department of 8 9 Labor and Workforce Development shall provide to any person, upon 10 that person's written request, that person's wage, employment, and 11 unemployment compensation records and information, and any other 12 records related to that person's employment maintained by the 13 department. The documentation shall be provided free of charge. 14 b.**1**<sup>1</sup> Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S.43:21-11 et seq., 15 or any other law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Department of 16 Labor and Workforce Development shall provide for and undertake 17 the electronic transmission of a person's wage, employment, and 18 unemployment compensation records and information, and any other 19 records related to that person's employment maintained by the 20 department, upon the request of that person, to any third party or 21 vendor authorized pursuant to an agreement with the department to 22 receive and transmit such information. <sup>1</sup>[c.] b.<sup>1</sup> The Department of Labor and Workforce Development 23 is authorized to enter into an agreement with one or more third parties 24 to implement the provisions of subsection <sup>1</sup>[b.] a.<sup>1</sup> of this section. 25 26 27

2. This act shall take effect immediately.
