4 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and the General Assembly of the
5 State of New Jersey:

7 1. In addition to the amounts appropriated under P.L.2022, c.49,
8 the annual appropriations act for the fiscal year ending June 30,
9 2023, there is appropriated from the General Fund the following
10 amount for the purpose specified:

23 The amount hereinabove appropriated for Hunterdon Health shall
24 be used to fund the construction and operation of an emergency
25 management and storage center on the campus of the Hunterdon
26 Medical Center in Flemington, New Jersey.

31 **STATEMENT**

32
33 This bill supplements the FY 2023 appropriations act by
34 appropriating \$3 million to the Department of Health for the
35 construction and operation of an emergency management and
36 storage center on the campus of the Hunterdon Medical Center in
37 Flemington.

38 The purpose of the new emergency management and storage
39 center will be to manage emergency operations and coordinate and
40 deliver resources to incident sites during emergency events.
41 According to Hunterdon Health's proposal, the warehouse-like
42 facility will be approximately 10,000-20,000 square feet in size.
43 When not utilized to respond to an emerging crisis, it is expected
44 that the building will store emergency supplies for Hunterdon
45 Medical Center, including beds, medical equipment such as IV
46 poles and ventilators, emergency response equipment such as
47 inflatables, decontamination equipment, and personal protective
48 equipment. As outlined in the proposal, during a catastrophe, the

1 facility would act as a hub to manage emergency operations and
2 coordinate and deliver resources to incident sites. Because of its
3 size, the facility could also serve as a field hospital unit, a supply
4 distribution point, or a shelter.

5 As a result of several recent regional and national crisis
6 situations, including the COVID-19 pandemic and Tropical Storm
7 Ida, and the expectation that similar events will continue to occur, it
8 is the sponsor's belief that Hunterdon county needs a facility that
9 can store equipment and respond immediately and effectively to an
10 emergency. As there is no other medical center within a 30-minute
11 drive of Flemington, it is expected that the new emergency
12 management and storage center will be at the forefront of any
13 medical emergency deriving from a natural disaster, attack, or mass
14 casualty event occurring in the area.
