Prohibits limiting number of county college credits that may be applied towards educator preparation program and teacher certification requirements.

#### **A5417** [1R] LAMPITT, JASEY

1	AN ACT concerning teacher certification and supplementing chapter
2	26 of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. <sup>1</sup>a. <sup>1</sup> Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a Commissioner-approved <sup>1</sup>[college] <sup>1</sup> educator preparation program shall not restrict the number of semester-hour credits <sup>1</sup>[earned in the field of professional education] of professional education coursework completed <sup>1</sup> at <sup>1</sup>[a] an accredited <sup>1</sup> county college that may be accepted toward meeting the <sup>1</sup>[program's] <sup>1</sup> requirements <sup>1</sup>for teacher certification <sup>1</sup>, except as may be otherwise required by the program's accrediting organization.

<sup>1</sup>b. As used in this section, "professional education coursework" means coursework required to obtain teacher certification, including courses in child development, language development, curriculum development, and methods of instruction. <sup>1</sup>

- 2. ¹a.¹ The State Board of Education shall not adopt any regulation or policy which restricts the number of semester-hour credits ¹[earned in the field of professional education] of professional education coursework completed¹ at ¹[a regionally] an¹ accredited county college that may be accepted toward meeting the requirements for teacher certification, provided that the credits are accepted by a ¹[State-approved college professional education] Commissioner-approved educator¹ preparation program.
- <sup>1</sup>b. As used in this section, "professional education coursework" means coursework required to obtain teacher certification, including courses in child development, language development, curriculum development, and methods of instruction. <sup>1</sup>

3. This act shall take effect immediately.
