Allows municipalities to conduct annual event for open burning of Christmas trees.

1	AN ACT concerning the open burning of Christmas trees by
2	municipalities and supplementing P.L.1954, c.212 (C.26:2C-1 e
3	seq.).

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

- 1. a. Notwithstanding the provisions of the "Air Pollution Control Act (1954)," P.L.1954, c.212 (C.26:2C-1 et seq.), or any rule or regulation adopted pursuant thereto, to the contrary, a municipality shall be permitted to conduct an event for the open burning of Christmas trees once per year. <sup>1</sup>The municipality shall ensure that all ornaments, lights, and other extraneous items are removed from the trees prior to conducting the burning. <sup>1</sup>
  - b. The Department of Environmental Protection shall adopt, pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), rules, regulations, and standards for the open burning of Christmas trees by municipalities within the State.

2. This act shall take effect immediately.
