A JOINT RESOLUTION designating October 11 of each year as the 1 2 "Day of the Girl" in New Jersey. 3 4 WHEREAS, In 2000, the United Nations adopted the Millennium 5 Development Goals; and WHEREAS, The eight Millennium Development Goals form a 6 7 blueprint agreed upon by 189 countries and the world's leading 8 development institutions to eliminate global poverty by 2015, and 9 implement policies that encourage sustained economic development 10 in the world's poorest countries; and WHEREAS, The third goal seeks to promote gender equality and 11 12 empower women by eliminating gender disparity in primary and 13 secondary education, and supporting universal access to education 14 for girls throughout the world; and 15 WHEREAS, In order to meet this goal, the United Nations General 16 Assembly adopted Resolution 66/170 in December 2011, to declare 17 October 11 of each year as the "International Day of the Girl Child"; and 18 19 WHEREAS, The resolution, which was co-sponsored by the United 20 States and supported by 97 other countries, recognizes girls' rights 21 and the unique social, economic, and educational challenges girls 22 under the age of 18 encounter around the world; and 23 WHEREAS, In order to promote the United Nations' efforts, the Day of the Girl campaign was established by School Girls Unite, a non-24 profit organization located in Washington D.C.; and 25 WHEREAS, The purpose of the campaign is to encourage communities 26 27 across the country to recognize the many injustices faced by girls 28 around the world, including gender gaps in education, child 29 marriage, human trafficking, female mutilation, and other forms of gender-specific violence; and 30 31 WHEREAS, The campaign also empowers girls to learn to fight for 32 their human rights, speak out against gender-based inequities, and 33 advocate for equality, so girls in the United States and worldwide 34 can pursue their dreams; and 35 WHEREAS, The establishment of October 11 as the "Day of the Girl" 36 will raise public awareness about the "International Day of the Girl 37 Child" and galvanize the support of the citizens of, and community-38 based organizations in, the State to help better girls' lives and provide them with equal opportunities to reach their full potential; 39 now, therefore, 40
