Transfers New Jersey State Forestry Services and related entities to Department of Agriculture.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

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1 AN ACT transferring the New Jersey State Forestry Services and 2 other related entities from the Department of Environmental 3 Protection to the Department of Agriculture, and supplementing Title 4 of the Revised Statutes. 4 5 6 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 7 of New Jersey: 8 9 1. As used in this act: "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Environmental 10 11 Protection. "Director" means the director of the Division of Parks and 12 Forestry in the Department of Environmental Protection. 13 14 "Forestry activity" means any forestry or silviculture activity 15 carried out to create, protect, conserve, harvest, monitor, study, or 16 otherwise manage trees or forested areas of the State. 17 "New Jersey State Forestry Services" means the State agency 18 heretofore in the Division of Parks and Forestry in the Department 19 of Environmental Protection, now transferred to the Department of Agriculture pursuant to section 2 of this act, that has heretofore 20 administered the forestry activities of the division, notwithstanding 21 22 any instances in law or elsewhere that may refer to the New Jersey 23 State Forestry Services by a different name. 24 25 2. a. The New Jersey State Forestry Services in the Division of 26 Parks and Forestry in the Department of Environmental Protection, together with all its functions, powers, duties, programs, 27 subdivisions, and other entities, is continued as the New Jersey 28 29 State Forestry Services in the Department of Agriculture. Whenever any law, rule, regulation, order, contract, proceeding or 30 31 document makes reference to the New Jersey State Forestry 32 Services in the Division of Parks and Forestry in the Department of Environmental Protection, the reference shall be read to mean the 33 34 New Jersey State Forestry Services in the Department of 35 Agriculture. 36 b. All the functions, powers, duties, programs, subdivisions, 37 and other entities of the Department of Environmental Protection, 38 or the Division of Parks and Forestry therein, that pertain to forestry 39 activities heretofore administered by the New Jersey State Forestry 40 Services, are continued in the Department of Agriculture. 41 Whenever any law, rule, regulation, order, contract, proceeding or 42 document makes reference to the Department of Environmental 43 Protection or the Division of Parks and Forestry therein, regarding 44 an agency function, power, duty, or program that pertains to 45 forestry activities heretofore administered by the New Jersey State 46 Forestry Services, the reference shall be read to mean the 47 Department of Agriculture.

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c. All the functions, powers, and duties of the commissioner or 1 2 director, or any agent thereof, that pertain to forestry activities 3 heretofore administered by the New Jersey State Forestry Services, 4 are continued in the Secretary of Agriculture. Whenever any law, 5 rule, regulation, order, contract, proceeding or document makes 6 reference to the commissioner or director regarding a function, 7 power, or duty of the commissioner or director that pertains to 8 forestry activities heretofore administered by the New Jersey State 9 Forestry Services, the reference shall be read to mean the Secretary 10 of Agriculture.

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12 3. The State Forester in the Department of Environmental Protection, established pursuant to section 17 of P.L.1983, 13 14 c.324 (C.13:1L-17), together with all the functions, powers, and 15 duties thereof, is continued as the State Forester in the Department 16 of Agriculture. Whenever in any law, rule, regulation, or order the 17 term State Forester in the Department of Environmental Protection 18 is used, the term shall mean State Forester in the Department of 19 Agriculture. Whenever any law grants the Department of Environmental Protection, or the commissioner thereof, review, 20 21 control, or power over or relating to the State Forester, that review, 22 control, or power shall be exercised by the Department of 23 Agriculture, or the secretary thereof.

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25 4. The New Jersey Board of Tree Experts in the Department of 26 Environmental Protection, established pursuant to section 3 of 27 P.L.2009, c.237 (C.45:15C-13), together with all its functions, 28 powers, duties, subdivisions, and other entities, is continued as the 29 New Jersey Board of Tree Experts in the Department of 30 Agriculture. Whenever in any law, rule, regulation, or order the 31 term New Jersey Board of Tree Experts in the Department of 32 Environmental Protection is used, the term shall mean New Jersey 33 Board of Tree Experts in the Department of Agriculture. Whenever 34 any law grants the Department of Environmental Protection, or the 35 commissioner thereof, review, control, or power over or relating to 36 the New Jersey Board of Tree Experts, that review, control, or 37 power shall be exercised by the Department of Agriculture, or the 38 secretary thereof.

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40 The Community Forestry Council in the Department of 5. 41 Environmental Protection, established pursuant to section 5 of 42 P.L.1996, c.135 (C.13:1L-17.5), together with all its functions, 43 powers, duties, subdivisions, and other entities, is continued as the 44 Community Forestry Council in the Department of Agriculture. 45 Whenever in any law, rule, regulation, or order the term 46 Community Forestry Council in the Department of Environmental 47 Protection is used, the term shall mean the Community Forestry 48 Council in the Department of Agriculture. Whenever any law

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1 grants the Department of Environmental Protection, or the 2 commissioner thereof, review, control, or power over or relating to 3 the Community Forestry Council, that review, control, or power 4 shall be exercised by the Department of Agriculture, or the 5 secretary thereof.

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7 The Forest Stewardship Advisory Committee in the 6. 8 Department of Environmental Protection, established pursuant to 9 section 8 of P.L.2009, c.256 (C.13:1L-36), together with all its 10 functions, powers, duties, subdivisions, and other entities, is continued as the Forest Stewardship Advisory Committee in the 11 12 Department of Agriculture. Whenever in any law, rule, regulation, 13 or order the term Forest Stewardship Advisory Committee in the 14 Department of Environmental Protection is used, the term shall 15 mean the Forest Stewardship Advisory Committee in the 16 Department of Agriculture. Whenever any law grants the 17 Department of Environmental Protection, or the commissioner 18 thereof, review, control, or power over or relating to the Forest 19 Stewardship Advisory Committee, that review, control, or power 20 shall be exercised by the Department of Agriculture, or the 21 secretary thereof.

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23 The Forest Health Advisory Council in the Department of 7. 24 Environmental Protection, established pursuant to section 2 of 25 P.L.2007, c.44 (C.13:1L-27), together with all its functions, powers, 26 duties, subdivisions, and other entities, is continued as the Forest 27 Health Advisory Council in the Department of Agriculture. 28 Whenever in any law, rule, regulation, or order the term Forest 29 Health Advisory Council in the Department of Environmental 30 Protection is used, the term shall mean the Forest Health Advisory 31 Council in the Department of Agriculture. Whenever any law 32 grants the Department of Environmental Protection, or the 33 commissioner thereof, review, control, or power over or relating to 34 the Forest Health Advisory Council, that review, control, or power 35 shall be exercised by the Department of Agriculture, or the 36 secretary thereof.

The transfers provided for pursuant to this act shall be 39 subject to the provisions of the "State Agency Transfer Act," P.L.1971, c.375 (C.52:14D-1 et seq.). All records, equipment and 40 41 other personal property, appropriations, and any unexpended 42 balances of funds appropriated or otherwise available to the New 43 Jersey State Forestry Services or other transferred entity, shall be 44 transferred to the Department of Agriculture pursuant to the "State 45 Agency Transfer Act."

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47 9. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATEMENT

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3 This bill transfers from the Department of Environmental4 Protection to the Department of Agriculture:

5 1) the New Jersey State Forestry Services in the Division of

- 6 Parks and Forestry;
- 7 2) the State Forester;

8 3) the New Jersey Board of Tree Experts;

9 4) the Community Forestry Council;

10 5) the Forest Stewardship Advisory Committee; and

11 6) the Forest Health Advisory Council.
