The State Treasurer shall be the custodian of the fund and all 38 39 disbursements from the fund shall be made by the State Treasurer 40 upon vouchers signed by the chairperson of the commission or the 41 chairperson's designee. The monies in the fund shall be invested and 42 reinvested by the Director of the Division of Investment in the 43 Department of the Treasury in the same manner as other trust funds in 44 the custody of the State Treasurer, in the manner provided by law.
