SYNOPSIS

Permits State Board of Education to authorize alternative teaching certificate.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

As reported by the Assembly Appropriations Committee on February 23, 2023, with amendments.

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AN ACT concerning teacher certification and supplementing chapter
26 of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

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BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

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⁴[1. a. The State Board of Education shall authorize the issuance 7 of an alternative certificate of eligibility with advanced standing to a 8 9 teacher candidate who meets all other eligibility requirements for a certificate of eligibility with advanced standing, except ¹ for¹ the 10 11 requirement to achieve a minimum passing score on an appropriate 12 State test of subject matter knowledge and all other alternative 13 requirements or exceptions to achieving a passing score on an 14 appropriate State test of subject matter knowledge.

15 b. The holder of an alternative certificate authorized pursuant to 16 subsection a. of this section shall be eligible to receive a standard 17 certificate from the State Board of Education upon completion of four years of continuous employment as a teacher in ¹[the State's public 18 schools] a school district, charter school, renaissance school project, 19 20 or an approved private school for students with disabilities¹, provided 21 that the teacher completes all applicable requirements for the standard 22 certificate.]⁴

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⁴[2.] <u>1.</u>⁴ a. The State Board of Education shall authorize the 24 issuance of an alternative certificate of eligibility to a teacher 25 candidate who meets all other eligibility requirements to receive a 26 certificate of eligibility, except ${}^{1}\underline{for}^{1}$ the requirement to achieve a 27 minimum score on a Commissioner of Education-approved test of 28 29 basic reading, writing, and mathematical skills and all other alternative 30 basic skills requirements or exceptions ⁴[; or the requirement to achieve a minimum passing score on an appropriate State test of 31 32 subject matter knowledge and all other alternative requirements or 33 exceptions to achieving a passing score on an appropriate State test of 34 subject matter knowledge]⁴.

35 b. The holder of an alternative certificate authorized pursuant to 36 subsection a. of this section shall be eligible to receive a standard 37 certificate from the State Board of Education upon completion of four years of continuous employment as a teacher in ¹[the State's public 38 39 schools] <u>a school district, charter school, renaissance school project,</u> 40 or approved private school for students with disabilities¹, provided that the teacher completes all applicable requirements for the standard 41 42 certificate.

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additional qualifications towards the acquisition of tenure other than those specified by law for all candidates for tenure. Employment accrued using an alternative certificate of eligibility ⁴[or an alternative certificate of eligibility with advanced standing]⁴ shall be applied in the same manner towards eligibility for tenure as employment accrued using a certificate of eligibility ⁴[or certificate of eligibility with advanced standing]⁴.
