1 AN ACT concerning county college tuition rates and supplementing
2 chapter 64A of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. United States military personnel and their dependents who
8 are living in New Jersey and are attending a county college
9 established by the county in which they reside or are stationed shall
10 be regarded as residents of the county for the purpose of
11 determining tuition.

13 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall first apply to
14 the ¹**[2022-2023]**¹ academic year ¹beginning after the effective
15 date of this act¹.
