1 **AN ACT** concerning the availability of mail-in ballot applications at
2 polling places and supplementing P.L.2009, c.79 (C.19:63-
3 1 et seq.).

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. The County Clerk shall cause to be made available at each
9 polling place on the day of any election copies of mail-in ballot
10 applications for future elections.

12 2. This act shall take effect on the January 1 next following the
13 date of enactment.

18 This bill requires mail-in ballot applications to be available at

20 the bill, the County Clerk would make available at each polling
21 place on the day of any election copies of mail-in ballot
