The Senate Health, Human Services and Senior Citizens Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 2302.

This act, which is designated as the “New Jersey Feminine Hygiene Products for the Homeless Act,” provides that emergency shelters for the homeless that provide services to female residents will be required, within the limits of available funds, to make feminine hygiene products, including, but not limited to, sanitary napkins, tampons, and panty liners, available free of charge to females residing in the shelter.

As reported by the committee, Senate Bill No. 2302 is identical to Assembly Bill No. 3211, which was also reported by the committee on this date.
