Provides project grants under “Securing Our Children’s Future Fund” for career and technical education at county vocational school districts; appropriates \$36,960,028.

1 AN ACT concerning project grants under the “Securing Our
2 Children’s Future Fund” for career and technical education
3 expansion in the State’s county vocational school districts and
4 making an appropriation.

6 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
7 *of New Jersey:*
8

9 1. a. There is appropriated from the “Securing Our Children’s
10 Future Fund,” established pursuant to section 13 of P.L.2018, c.119,
11 to the Department of Education the sum of \$36,960,028 to provide
12 grants for career and technical education expansion in the State’s
13 county vocational school districts. Project grants shall be approved
14 in the amounts set forth in subsection b. of this section.

15 b. Project grants shall be awarded in the amounts as follows:

16 (1) \$5,895,488 to the Burlington County Institute of Technology
17 for a project at the district’s campus in Medford, Burlington
18 County;

19 (2) \$10,416,657 to the Burlington County Institute of
20 Technology for a project at the district’s campus in Westampton,
21 Burlington County;

22 (3) \$14,450,859 to the Cape May County Technical High School
23 District in Cape May County;

24 (4) \$3,750,000 to the Hunterdon County Vocational School
25 District in Hunterdon County;

26 (5) \$197,024 to the Passaic County Vocational School District in
27 Passaic County; and

28 (6) \$2,250,000 to the Salem County Vocational Technical School
29 District in Salem County.

31 2. The expenditure of sums appropriated by this act shall be
32 subject to the provisions and conditions of the “Securing Our
33 Children’s Future Bond Act,” P.L.2018, c.119.

35 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
