Requires certain employers to provide certain employees with notifications concerning federal Public Service Loan Forgiveness program.

1 2	AN ACT concerning the explanation of benefits to new employees and supplementing Title 34 of the Revised Statutes.
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4	BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5	of New Jersey:
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7	1. An employer in the State who is designated as a qualifying
8	employer under the federal Public Service Loan Forgiveness
9	Program (PSLF), established under the "College Cost Reduction and
10	Access Act" (20 U.S.C. s.1087e), shall notify an employee during the
11	explanation of benefits conducted at the beginning of employment
12	of:
13	a. potential eligibility for the PSLF program; and
14	b. the requirements to be eligible for the PSLF program, which
15	include, but are not limited to, the following:
16	(1) employment with a qualifying employer;
17	(2) a work schedule of at least 30 hours per week with the
18	qualifying employer or a schedule that meets the qualifying
19	employer's definition of full-time work, whichever is greater;
20	(3) a balance with the William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan
21	(Direct Loan) Program offered by the U.S. Department of Education
22	or consolidation of other federal student loans into a Direct Loan;
23	(4) repayment of a Direct Loan under an income-driven
24	repayment plan; and
25	(5) payment of 120 monthly payments.
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27	2. This act shall take effect immediately.
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30	STATEMENT
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32	This bill requires an employer in the State who is designated as a
33	qualifying employer under the federal Public Service Loan
34	Forgiveness Program (PSLF), established under the "College Cost
35	Reduction and Access Act," to provide information concerning the
36	PSLF program to employees during the explanation of benefits
37	conducted at the beginning of employment.
38	Under this bill, a qualifying employer will be required to notify an
39	employee about potential eligibility for the PSLF program and of the
40	requirements to qualify for the PSLF program, which include, but are
41	not limited to, the following:
42	• employment by a qualifying employer;
43	• a work schedule of at least 30 hours per week for the
44	qualifying employer or a schedule that meets the qualifying
45	employer's definition of full-time work, whichever is
46	greater;
47	• a balance with the William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan
48	(Direct Loan) Program offered by the U.S. Department of

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1	Education or consolidation of other federal student loans
2	into a Direct Loan;
3	• repayment of loans under an income-driven repayment
4	plan; and
5	 payment of 120 payments.
