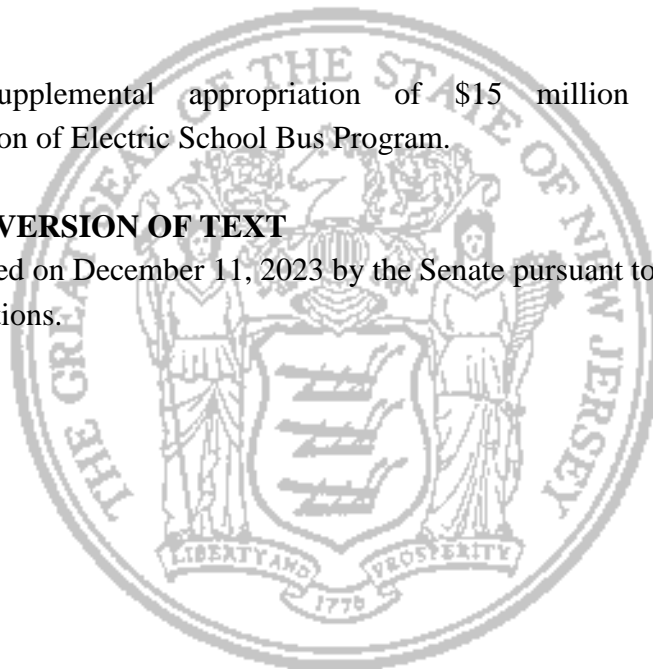

36 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or regulation to the
37 contrary, there is appropriated from the Clean Energy Fund to the
38 Department of Environmental Protection the amount of
39 \$15,000,000 for the purposes of supporting the Electric School
40 Bus Program, established pursuant to P.L.2022, c.86 (C.26:2C-
41 8.58).¹
