1 day care Medicaid per diem rate by four percent from \$86.10 to 2 Adult medical day care services provide medically 3 necessary services in an ambulatory care setting to individuals who 4 are nonresidents of the facility, and who, due to their physical or 5 cognitive impairment, require such services to support their 6 community living. The adult medical day care per diem rate was 7 increased from \$78.50 to \$82 in FY 21, and from \$82 to the current 8 rate in FY 22. Prior to these increases, the per diem rate was static 9 at \$78.50 since FY 12.
