33	This bill supplements the FY 2023 appropriations act by

38	The purpose of the new emergency management and storage

40	deliver resources to incident sites during emergency events.
41	According to Hunterdon Health's proposal, the warehouse-like
	facility will be approximately 10,000-20,000 square feet in size.
43	When not utilized to respond to an emerging crisis, it is expected
44	that the building will store emergency supplies for Hunterdon
45	Medical Center, including beds, medical equipment such as IV
46	poles and ventilators, emergency response equipment such as
47 48	inflatables, decontamination equipment, and personal protective
ДX	equipment. As outlined in the proposal dilring a catastrophe the

facility would act as a hub to manage emergency operations and coordinate and deliver resources to incident sites. Because of its size, the facility could also serve as a field hospital unit, a supply distribution point, or a shelter.

5 As a result of several recent regional and national crisis 6 situations, including the COVID-19 pandemic and Tropical Storm 7 Ida, and the expectation that similar events will continue to occur, it 8 is the sponsor's belief that Hunterdon county needs a facility that 9 can store equipment and respond immediately and effectively to an emergency. As there is no other medical center within a 30-minute 10 drive of Flemington, it is expected that the new emergency 11 12 management and storage center will be at the forefront of any 13 medical emergency deriving from a natural disaster, attack, or mass 14 casualty event occurring in the area.
