Prohibits mandatory vaccination against COVID-19 as condition of attending public K-12 schools.

2 supplementing Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. In no case shall the Commissioner of Health or any other
8 entity of State government require immunization against SARS-
9 CoV-2 as a condition of attendance at a public primary or secondary
10 school.

12 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

15 STATEMENT

16

17 This bill prohibits the Commissioner of Health and other State
18 governmental entities from requiring immunization against SARS-
19 CoV-2, the virus that causes coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19),
20 as a condition of attendance at a public primary or secondary
21 school.
