N.J.S.18A:38-3 is amended to read as follows: 7 8 18A:38-3. a. Any person not resident in a school district, if 9 eligible except for residence, may be admitted to the schools of the district with the consent of the board of education upon [such] 10 terms, and with [or without] ¹or without¹ payment of tuition 11 ¹[<u>equal to the actual cost per pupil</u>]¹, as the board may prescribe. 12 13 b. Any person not resident in a school district, if eligible except 14 for residence, and if that person previously was a resident of the 15 district, shall be admitted to the schools of the district without 16 payment of tuition if that person's parent or guardian is a member of the New Jersey National Guard or a member of the reserve 17 18 component of the armed forces of the United States and has been 19 ordered into active military service in any of the armed forces of the United States in time of war or national emergency, resulting in the 20 21 relocation of the student out of the district. A school district 22 admitting a student pursuant to this subsection shall not be 23 obligated for transportation costs. c. ¹[A school district under partial or full State intervention 24 25 pursuant to P.L.2007, c.16 (18A:7A-3 et seq.) shall not admit a student who does not reside in the school district to the schools of 26 27 the district. d. The provisions of subsections a. and c. of this section shall 28 29 not apply, regardless of residence, to the enrolled children of 30 teaching staff members of the school district or county vocational 31 school district who are permitted, by contract or local district 32 policy, to enroll their children in the educational program of the 33 school district or county vocational school district without payment 34 of tuition Notwithstanding any other law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, a board of education shall not admit any person that does 35 not reside in a school district for the purposes of participation in a 36 37 school sport or other extracurricular activity without the consent of 38 the board of education and with payment of tuition equal to the actual cost per pupil¹. 39 (cf: P.L.1994, c.169, s.2)]² 40 41 42 ²1. Each board of education, with the approval of the executive county superintendent, shall establish a uniform tuition amount for any nonresident student admitted to the schools of a district pursuant to this section.
