#### SYNOPSIS

Expands eligibility for "fishing buddy license" fee.

### **CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT**

As reported by the Senate Environment and Energy Committee on May 15, 2023, with amendments.

AN ACT concerning fishing licenses and amending P.L.1982, c.180 1 2 and R.S.23:3-4. 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. Section 11 of P.L.1982, c.180 (C.23:3-1.1) is amended to read 8 as follows: 9 11. a. The division shall issue a special license combining the 10 resident's firearm hunting license, the resident's bow and arrow license and the resident's fishing license as provided under 11 12 R.S.23:3-4 into one license to be designated as the "All Around 13 Sportsman License." b. The "All Around Sportsman License" shall authorize its 14 15 holder to hunt with a shotgun or bow and arrow and to angle or attempt to take fish in the fresh waters of this State at the time, and 16 17 in the manner, provided by law and the State Fish and Game Code, 18 except that this license shall not authorize its holder to take trout 19 from the fresh waters of the State. 20 A resident of this State above the age of 16 years may c. procure the "All Around Sportsman License" from the division at 21 22 Trenton or from its agents as designated by the division. It shall not 23 be valid unless it contains the signature of the owner written in ink. 24 Each license issued under this section shall expire on December 31 25 next following its issuance. 26 The division shall determine the form of the "All d. (1) 27 Around Sportsman License." The fee for this license shall be \$71.25 and an issuance fee of \$1.00, or as adjusted by the Fish and 28 29 Game Council pursuant to section 12 of P.L.1982, c.180 (C.23:3-30 1a). 31 (2) The fee for an "All Around Sportsman License" shall be 32 reduced by \$10 when application therefor is made at the same time 33 with: (1) another resident of this State who applies for a resident's 34 fishing license, is above 16 years of age and below 65 years of age, and has not bought an "All Around Sportsman License" or resident's 35 fishing license [after 2010] in the previous five license years, or 36 37 (2) a nonresident who applies for a nonresident's annual fishing 38 license, is above 16 years of age, and has not bought a nonresident's annual fishing license [after 2010] in the previous five license 39 40 years. The fee for a resident's fishing license bought in accordance 41 with the requirements of this paragraph shall be \$10.75 and an issuance fee of \$1.00, and the fee for a nonresident's annual fishing 42 43 license bought in accordance with the requirements of this 44 paragraph shall be \$16.50 and an issuance fee of \$1.00.

1 The amounts remitted to the State Treasury from the e. 2 collection of any fee pursuant to this section shall be deposited to 3 the credit of the "hunters' and anglers' license fund." 4 (cf: P.L.2015, c.99, s.1) 5 6 2. R.S.23:3-4 is amended to read as follows: 7 23:3-4. The licenses issued under this article shall include, 8 among others authorized by law, the following: 9 a. A license issued to a person above 16 years of age, or in the 10 case of an apprentice firearm hunting license or an apprentice bow 11 and arrow license, a license issued to a person above 14 years of 12 age, who has an actual and bona fide domicile in this State at the 13 time of the application for the license and who has had an actual 14 and bona fide domicile in this State for at least six months 15 immediately prior thereto, provided that for a resident's trapping 16 license the person shall be above 12 years of age. These licenses 17 shall be designated as the resident's firearm hunting license, the 18 resident's bow and arrow license, the resident's trapping license, the 19 resident's fishing license, the resident's apprentice firearm hunting 20 license, and the resident's apprentice bow and arrow license. 21 (1) (a) The resident's firearm hunting license shall authorize its 22 holder to hunt with hounds and firearms only, and a fee of \$26.50 23 and an issuance fee of \$1.00 shall be charged therefor, except that a 24 person above the age of 65 years shall be charged a fee of \$14.50 25 and an issuance fee of \$1.00. 26 (b) The resident's apprentice firearm hunting license shall 27 authorize its holder to hunt only with hounds and firearms and only 28 when accompanied by a holder, above 21 years of age, of a regular 29 resident's or nonresident's firearm hunting license. A fee of \$26.50 30 and an issuance fee of \$1.00 shall be charged for a resident's 31 apprentice firearm hunting license, except that a person above the 32 age of 65 years shall be charged a fee of \$14.50 and an issuance fee 33 of \$1.00. The resident's apprentice firearm hunting license may be 34 issued to a person only twice during the lifetime of the person. 35 (2) (a) The resident's bow and arrow license shall authorize its 36 holder to hunt with bow and arrow only, and a fee of \$30.50 and an 37 issuance fee of \$1.00 shall be charged therefor, except that a person 38 above the age of 65 years shall be charged a fee of \$15.50 and an 39 issuance fee of \$1.00. 40 (b) The resident's apprentice bow and arrow license shall 41 authorize its holder to hunt only with bow and arrow and only when 42 accompanied by a holder, above 21 years of age, of a regular 43 resident's or nonresident's bow and arrow license. A fee of \$30.50 44 and an issuance fee of \$1.00 shall be charged for a resident's 45 apprentice bow and arrow license, except that a person above the

age of 65 years shall be charged a fee of \$15.50 and an issuance fee
of \$1.00. The resident's apprentice bow and arrow license may be
issued to a person only twice during the lifetime of the person.

(3) The resident's trapping license shall authorize its holder to
trap only, and a fee of \$31.50 and an issuance fee of \$1.00 shall be
charged therefor, except that a person above 12 years and under 16
years of age shall be charged no fee.

8 (4) The resident's fishing license shall authorize its holder to 9 fish only, and a fee of \$21.50 and an issuance fee of \$1.00 shall be 10 charged therefor, except (a) in any case where the applicant is 11 above 70 years of age and is otherwise qualified, no license shall be 12 required, (b) a person above 65 years and under 70 years of age shall be charged a fee of \$11.50 and an issuance fee of \$1.00, and 13 14 (c) as otherwise provided in paragraph (5) of this subsection, 15 paragraph (2) of subsection c. of this section, or paragraph (2) of 16 subsection d. of section 11 of P.L.1982, c.180 (C.23:3-1.1).

17 (5) The resident's fishing buddy license shall authorize its 18 holder to fish only, and can only be obtained through application at 19 the same time with: (a) another resident of this State who applies 20 for a resident's fishing license, is above 16 years of age and below 21 65 years of age, and has not bought a resident's fishing license 22 [after 2010] in the previous five license years, or (b) a nonresident 23 who applies for a nonresident's annual fishing license, is above 16 24 years of age, and has not bought a nonresident's annual fishing 25 license [after 2010] in the previous five license years. The fee for 26 a resident's fishing buddy license and for a resident's fishing license 27 issued pursuant to this paragraph shall each be \$10.75 and an 28 issuance fee of \$1.00. The fee for a nonresident's annual fishing 29 license issued pursuant to this paragraph shall be \$16.50 and an 30 issuance fee of \$1.00.

31 (6) Any resident of this State who is totally blind, upon
32 application to the division, shall be entitled to a resident's fishing
33 license without fee or charge.

34 b. A license issued to a person above 16 years of age, or in the 35 case of an apprentice firearm hunting license or an apprentice bow 36 and arrow license, a license issued to a person above 14 years of 37 age, not entitled to a resident's license, authorizing the person to 38 trap or to hunt, as applicable, except that a nonresident's two-day 39 small game firearm hunting license shall not permit the taking, 40 hunting, or killing of deer or turkey. These licenses shall be 41 designated as the nonresident's firearm hunting license, the 42 nonresident's apprentice firearm hunting license, the nonresident's 43 bow and arrow license, the nonresident's apprentice bow and arrow 44 license, the nonresident's trapping license, and the nonresident's 45 two-day small game firearm hunting license.

1 A nonresident's apprentice firearm hunting license shall 2 authorize its holder to hunt only with hounds and firearms and only 3 when accompanied by a holder, above 21 years of age, of a regular 4 resident's or nonresident's firearm hunting license. A nonresident's 5 apprentice bow and arrow license shall authorize its holder to hunt with bow and arrow only and only when accompanied by a holder, 6 7 above 21 years of age, of a regular resident's or nonresident's bow 8 and arrow license. The nonresident's apprentice firearm hunting 9 license and the nonresident's apprentice bow and arrow license may 10 each be issued to a person only twice during the lifetime of the 11 person.

12 (1) The fees for the nonresident's firearm hunting license, the 13 nonresident's apprentice firearm hunting license, the nonresident's 14 bow and arrow license, and the nonresident's apprentice bow and 15 arrow license shall each be \$134.50 and an issuance fee of \$1.00.

16 (2) The fee for the nonresident's trapping license shall be 17 \$199.50 and an issuance fee of \$1.00.

18 (3) The fee for a nonresident's two-day small game firearm hunting license shall be \$35.50 and an issuance fee of \$1.00. 19

20 c. A license issued to a person above 16 years of age not 21 entitled to a resident's license, authorizing the person to fish only. 22 These licenses shall be designated as the nonresident's annual 23 fishing license, the nonresident's annual fishing buddy license, the 24 nonresident's two-day fishing license, valid for a period of two 25 consecutive days, and the nonresident's seven-day vacation fishing 26 license, valid for a period of seven consecutive days.

27 The nonresident's annual fishing buddy license can only be 28 obtained through application at the same time with: a resident of 29 this State who applies for a resident's fishing license, is above 16 30 years of age and below 65 years of age, and has not bought a 31 resident's fishing license [after 2010] in the previous five license 32 years; or a nonresident who applies for a nonresident's annual 33 fishing license, is above 16 years of age, and has not bought a 34 nonresident's annual fishing license [after 2010] in the previous 35 five license years .

36 (1) The fee for the nonresident's annual fishing license shall be 37 \$33.00 and an issuance fee of \$1.00, except as otherwise provided 38 pursuant to paragraph (2) of this subsection, paragraph (5) of 39 subsection a. of this section, or paragraph (2) of subsection d. of 40 section 11 of P.L.1982, c.180 (C.23:3-1.1).

41 (2) The fee for a nonresident's annual fishing buddy license 42 shall be \$16.50 and an issuance fee of \$1.00. The fee for a 43 resident's fishing license obtained through application at the same 44 time with an application for a nonresident's annual fishing buddy 45 license in accordance with this subsection shall be \$10.75 and an

1 issuance fee of \$1.00, and the fee for a nonresident's annual fishing 2 license obtained through application at the same time with an 3 application for a nonresident's annual fishing buddy license in accordance with this subsection shall be \$16.50 and an issuance fee 4 5 of \$1.00. (3) The fee for the nonresident's two-day fishing license shall be 6 7 \$8.00 and an issuance fee of \$1.00. (4) The fee for the nonresident's seven-day fishing license shall 8 9 be \$18.50 and an issuance fee of \$1.00. 10 d. Every license issued hereunder shall be void after December 11 31 next succeeding its issuance, except the one-day hunting license, 12 which shall expire on the date of issuance; the nonresident's seven-13 day fishing license, which is valid only for seven consecutive days after date of issuance; the nonresident's two-day fishing license, 14 15 which shall expire on the day after the date of issuance; and the 16 nonresident's two-day small game firearm hunting license, which 17 shall expire on the day after the date of issuance. 18 Any license issued hereunder to a person under 16 years of age 19 shall be void after December 31 of the year in which the licensee 20 becomes 16 years of age. 21 e. The fees for licenses set forth in this section may be adjusted 22 by the Fish and Game Council pursuant to section 12 of P.L.1982, 23 c.180 (C.23:3-1a). (cf: P.L.2017, c.131, s.63) 24 25 3. This act shall take effect <sup>1</sup>[immediately] <u>on the first December</u> 26 1st occurring at least six months after the date of enactment of this act, 27 28 except that the Department of Environmental Protection may take 29 anticipatory administrative action, in advance of the effective date, as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this  $act^{1}$ . 30
