## S4157 SINGLETON, CORRADO

1 AN ACT concerning military service members at public institutions 2 of higher education and supplementing chapter 62 of Title 18A 3 of the New Jersey Statutes. 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 1. a. A public institution of higher education shall readmit an 9 undergraduate student who withdrew from the institution due to the 10 student's service in the uniformed services, including service in the 11 Armed Forces, or as a member of the National Guard or Reserve, on 12 active duty, active duty for training, or full-time National Guard duty under federal or State authority. The institution shall readmit 13 14 the student with the same academic status as the student had when 15 the student last attended the institution. 16 b. Readmission shall be granted upon written request by the 17 student for the next academic semester beginning after the date of 18 the request. An institution shall not charge an application or other fee for a readmission request made pursuant to the provisions of 19 this section. 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall first apply to 23 the first full academic year following the date of enactment. 24 25 26 **STATEMENT** 27 This bill requires a public institution of higher education to 28 29 readmit an undergraduate student who withdrew from the institution due to the student's service in the uniformed services, including 30 31 service in the Armed Forces, or as a member of the National Guard 32 or Reserve, on active duty, active duty for training, or full-time 33 National Guard duty under federal or State authority. Under the bill, 34 the institution is required to readmit the student with the same 35 academic status as the student had when the student last attended 36 the institution. 37 The bill also provides that readmission is to be granted upon written request by the student for the next academic semester 38 39 beginning after the date of the request. Finally, the bill provides

40 that an institution cannot charge an application or other fee for a 41 readmission request made pursuant to the bill's provisions.
