7	negatives to recognize and appreciate what is positive in life; and
8	WHEREAS, Research has shown that gratitude can enhance moods,
9	decrease stress, and drastically improve a person's overall level of
10	health and wellbeing; and
11	WHEREAS, Over 90 percent of American teens and adults indicated
12	that expressing gratitude made them happy; and
13	WHEREAS, Gratitude helps people feel more positive emotions, relish
14	good experiences, improve their health, deal with adversity, and
15	build strong relationships; and
16	WHEREAS, The month of November holds national holidays, such as
17	Veterans Day and Thanksgiving, both of which embody the
18	meaning of gratitude; and
19	WHEREAS, Veterans are honored in November and are shown
20	gratitude for all of their noble sacrifices to protect and serve the
21	United States of America; and
22	WHEREAS, These sacrifices by veterans, provide the citizens of New
