Prohibits any foreign company created under laws of foreign adversary from participating in critical infrastructure.

AN ACT concerning critical infrastructure and supplementing 1 2 chapter 9 of Appendix A. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. a. As used in this section: 8 "Critical infrastructure" means property and equipment owned or 9 used by communication networks, electric generation, transmission, 10 and distribution systems, gas distribution systems, water pipelines, and related support facilities that serve multiple customers and 11 12 residents, including, but not limited to, real and personal property such as buildings, offices, lines, poles, pipes, structures, and 13 14 equipment. 15 "Foreign adversary" means any foreign government determined by the United States Secretary of Commerce to have engaged in a 16 17 long-term pattern or serious instances of conduct significantly 18 adverse to the national security of the United States or the security 19 and safety of United States persons. b. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, 20 the State of New Jersey, and all agencies or political subdivisions 21 22 thereof, shall not allow the participation of a foreign company 23 created under the laws of any foreign adversary in the construction, 24 maintenance, or control of any critical infrastructure in this State. 25 This section shall not apply to agreements entered into prior c. 26 to the enactment date of P.L., c. (C.) (pending before the 27 Legislature as this bill), except that any agreement that contradicts 28 the provisions of this section shall not be renewed. 29 30 2. This act shall take immediately. 31 32 33 **STATEMENT** 34 35 This bill prohibits any foreign company created under the laws of a foreign adversary from participating in critical infrastructure in 36 37 this State. 38 The bill defines "foreign adversary" to mean any foreign 39 government determined by the United States Secretary of Commerce to have engaged in a long-term pattern or serious 40 instances of conduct significantly adverse to the national security of 41 42 the United States or the security and safety of United States 43 persons. 44 Under the bill, the State of New Jersey, and all agencies or 45 political subdivisions thereof, are prohibited from allowing a 46 foreign company created under the laws of a foreign adversary to 47 participate in the construction, maintenance, or control of any

Critical infrastructure includes communication networks, electric 1 2 generation, gas distribution systems, water pipelines, and related 3 support facilities, such as buildings, offices, lines, poles, pipes, 4 structures, and equipment. The State's safety, security, and stability 5 depend on protecting critical infrastructure from foreign 6 adversaries. The disruption of these key services would 7 significantly disrupt the well-being of the people of this State and 8 the functioning of the economy. The involvement of a foreign 9 company created under the laws of a foreign adversary raises 10 substantial security threats, such as cyber-attacks or the intentional 11 disruption of services. Accordingly, to protect against risks posed 12 by foreign adversaries, it is crucial to ensure that only trusted entities control the State's critical infrastructure. 13
