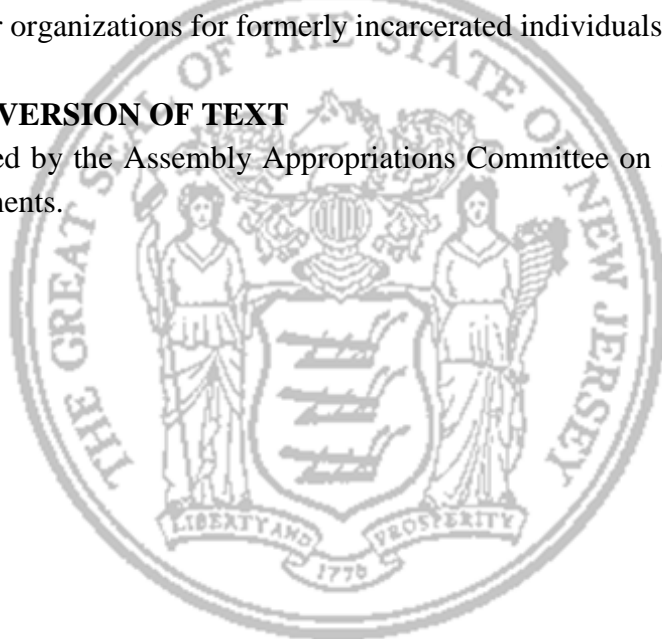

SYNOPSIS

Establishes Second Chance Program in charge of providing opportunities through labor organizations for formerly incarcerated individuals.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

1 AN ACT concerning employment opportunities for individuals
2 returning to the workforce after imprisonment and supplementing
3 Title 34 of the Revised Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6 of New Jersey:

7
8 1. The Legislature finds and declares that:

9 a. There is a lack of viable employment opportunities in New
10 Jersey for individuals recently released from prison;

11 b. Employment opportunities are necessary to curtail the rate of
12 recidivism and to reincorporate recently incarcerated individuals
13 back into civil society;

14 c. Individuals with low educational attainment are at greater
15 risk of engaging in criminal activity since they have tremendous
16 difficulty finding and maintaining adequate jobs; and

17 d. Labor organizations, given their unique understanding of
18 their community's economic conditions are in the best position to
19 identify employment opportunities for recently incarcerated
20 individuals and to propose a plan for attracting such employment
21 opportunities into their respective trades.

23 2. There is established, in the Department of Labor and
24 Workforce Development, the Second Chance Program (program).

25 ¹**[**The program shall be under the direction of the State
26 Employment and Training Commission as part of the commission's
27 responsibilities pursuant to subsection d. of section 9 of P.L.1989,
28 c.293 (C.34:15C-6).**]**¹ The purpose of the program shall be to
29 provide real and lasting career opportunities for formerly
30 incarcerated individuals through, and in consultation with, labor
31 organizations in order to reduce recidivism.

32 For the purposes of this section, "labor organization" means a
33 labor organization as defined in section 3 of 29 U.S.C. s.402.

34
35 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
