SYNOPSIS

Clarifies which health care professional may provide documentation to school district of need for home instruction due to student's health condition.

1 AN ACT concerning the provision of home instruction by school
2 districts and supplementing chapter 40 of Title 18A of the New
3 Jersey Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6 of New Jersey:

8 1. a. A parent or guardian requesting home instruction due to a
9 student's temporary or chronic health condition or need for treatment
10 that precludes participation in the student's usual education setting,
11 whether general education or special education, shall submit to the
12 board of education a request that includes a written determination from
13 the student's physician ¹physician assistant¹ or advanced practice
14 nurse documenting the projected need for confinement at the student's
15 residence or other treatment setting for more than 10 consecutive
16 school days or ¹**[20]** 15¹ cumulative school days during the school
17 year.

18 b. The provisions of this section shall be in addition to any other
19 requirement for the receipt of home instruction established pursuant to
20 State Board of Education regulations.

22 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
