1 AN ACT requiring the State to survey and report on special
2 improvement districts and supplementing P.L.1972, c.134
3 (C.40:56-65 et seq.).

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6 of New Jersey:

8 1. Prior to the first day of the sixth month next following
9 enactment of P.L. , c. (C.) (pending before the Legislature
10 as this bill), the Department of Community Affairs shall complete a
11 survey of New Jersey municipalities to ascertain each special
12 improvement district established by ordinance within the State,
13 prepare a list identifying each special improvement district within
14 the State, and publish the list on the department's Internet website.
15 The department shall update and republish the list at least every two
16 years thereafter.

18 2. The Commissioner of Community Affairs may promulgate,
19 pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410
20 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), such rules and regulations as may be
21 appropriate or necessary to implement the provisions of
22 P.L. , c. (C.) (pending before the Legislature as this bill).

24 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

29 The bill requires the Department of Community Affairs (DCA)
30 to complete a survey of New Jersey municipalities within six
31 months following the bill's enactment, to ascertain each special
32 improvement district established by ordinance within the State, to
33 prepare a list identifying each special improvement district within
34 the State, and publish the list on the department's Internet website.
35 The bill requires DCA to update and republish the list every two
36 years thereafter.
