4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. The Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission shall  
8 adopt regulations, pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act,"  
9 P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), authorizing licensees to  
10 accept payment in the form of credit cards, debit cards, or other  
11 electronic payment device for the purpose of allowing an individual  
12 to participate in a raffle, bingo, or penny auction under the "Bingo  
13 Licensing Law," P.L.1954, c.6 (C.5:8-24 et seq.), and the "Raffles  
14 Licensing Law," P.L.1954, c.5 (C.5:8-50 et seq.).

16 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

21 This bill would permit the use of credit cards, debit cards, and  
22 other electronic payment devices for the sale of shares, tickets, or  
23 rights to participate in raffles, bingo games, penny auctions, and  
24 any other legalized games of chance the Legalized Games of  
25 Chance Control Commission deems appropriate. The bill requires  
26 the commission to adopt regulations to accept credit cards and other  
27 electronic payments. Current law does not expressly permit the use  
28 of credit card or electronic payments to purchase shares, tickets, or  
29 rights to participate in legalized games of chance such as raffles,  
30 bingo, and penny auctions.
