- 1. a. For purposes of this section:
- "Flash mob" ¹[or "pop-up party"] ¹ means a gathering ¹or pop-up party ¹ of 50 or more persons, typically organized through social media or other electronic communication, that occurs without advance notice to the municipality or other local governmental unit and that impacts public safety.

"Large-scale gathering" means any public or private gathering with greater than 500 attendees.

- b. The Attorney General, in consultation with the Superintendent of State Police, the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management, and the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police, shall establish a training program for any municipal police department or force located within a municipality that, within the preceding twelve months, hosted two or more large-scale ¹[social] ¹ gatherings or ¹[had] where ¹ a flash mob ¹[or pop-up party occur] occurred ¹. The training program shall include, but not be limited to:
 - (1) general crowd management techniques;
 - (2) crowd management techniques applicable to juveniles;
- (3) strategies for responding to social media activity related to large-scale gatherings ¹or flash mobs ¹;
- (4) best practices for coordination and resource sharing with neighboring law enforcement agencies; and
- (5) best practices for ensuring the safety of attendees, the public, and law enforcement during a ¹ [flash mob or] ¹ large-scale gathering ¹ or flash mob ¹.
- c. The Attorney General shall make the following resources available to any ¹ [local or] ¹ municipal police department or force that has participated in the training program established pursuant to subsection b. of this section:
 - (1) access to social media monitoring tools;
- 38 (2) mobile command units that may be deployed during a large-39 scale gathering or, if practicable, during a flash mob ¹ [or pop-up 40 party]¹; and
- 41 (3) ¹ [additional] ¹ personnel ¹ [support] ¹ from the New Jersey 42 State Police ¹ to provide support ¹, as needed.
