SYNOPSIS

Prohibits requirement for beach tag for surfers and fishermen for access to beach below mean high tide line.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

As introduced.



1 AN ACT concerning beach access, and supplementing Title 40 of the
2 Revised Statutes.

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4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

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7 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law, or rule or
8 regulation adopted pursuant thereto, to the contrary, a municipality
9 shall not require a municipal beach tag or similar admission pass for
10 access to the wet sandy beach below the mean high tide line, for a
11 surfer or a fisherman for the exclusive purpose of surfing or fishing.

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13 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATEMENT

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18 This bill would prohibit a municipality from requiring a
19 municipal beach tag or similar admission pass for access to the wet
20 sandy beach below the mean high tide line, for a surfer or a
21 fisherman for the exclusive purpose of surfing or fishing.
