**SYNOPSIS**

Reconstitutes “Joint Committee on Economic Justice and Equal Employment Opportunity.”

**CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT**

As reported by the Assembly Labor Committee on February 5, 2024, with amendments.

1   **A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION** reconstituting the “Joint Committee  
2       on Economic Justice and Equal Employment Opportunity.”

3  
4       **BE IT RESOLVED** *by the General Assembly of the State of New*  
5       *Jersey (the Senate concurring):*

7       1. The “Joint Committee on Economic Justice and Equal  
8       Employment Opportunity,” created by the 216th Legislature and  
9       reconstituted in the <sup>1</sup>**[218<sup>th</sup> and 219<sup>th</sup> Legislature]** 218th, 219th, and  
10       220th Legislatures<sup>1</sup>, is reconstituted. The joint committee shall  
11       consist of 10 members of the Legislature, from either House,  
12       regardless of political party affiliation, who shall be appointed by  
13       the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the General  
14       Assembly, as appropriate, and nominated as follows: four members  
15       nominated by the President of the Senate; one member nominated  
16       by the Senate Minority Leader; four members nominated by the  
17       Speaker of the General Assembly; and one member nominated by  
18       the Assembly Minority Leader. All members shall serve without  
19       compensation and vacancies in the membership of the joint  
20       committee shall be filled in the same manner as the original  
21       appointments are made.

23       2. The joint committee shall adopt rules for the operation and  
24       the conduct of its business, including the election of a chair or co-  
25       chairs as it may determine from among its members, and select a  
26       secretary who need not be a member of the joint committee.

27  
28       3. The joint committee is authorized, empowered, and directed  
29       to conduct a continuing study of issues concerning economic justice  
30       and equal employment opportunity in this State. The joint  
31       committee, in its endeavor to study these issues, shall meet and hold  
32       hearings at places, throughout the State, as it shall designate during  
33       the sessions or recesses of the Legislature.

35       4. The joint committee shall be entitled to call to its assistance  
36       and avail itself of the services of the employees of the Legislative  
37       Services Commission. The joint committee shall also be entitled to  
38       employ such stenographic and clerical assistants and incur such  
39       traveling and other miscellaneous expenses as may be authorized by  
40       the presiding officers of the Houses, in order to perform its duties,  
41       and as may be within the limits of funds appropriated or otherwise  
42       made available to it for its purposes.
