1 AN ACT concerning a study on effects of temporary employment
2 and supplementing Title 34 of the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

6

7 1. a. The Department of Labor and Workforce Development
8 shall undertake a study on the effects of temporary employment on
9 the workforce in the State of New Jersey. The study shall consider
10 the comprehensive effects of temporary employment, and shall
11 include, but not be limited to, the effects of temporary employment
12 on workers, employment, wages, businesses, and the economy
13 throughout the State.

14 b. In conducting its study, the department shall:

15 (1) consider federal and State laws relating directly or indirectly
16 to temporary help service firms and employment agencies,
17 including but not limited, to P.L.1989, c.331 (C.34:8-43 et al.) and
18 P.L.1981, c.1 (C.56:8-1.1 et al.), and other federal and State laws
19 relating to employment, compensation, taxation and retirement;

20 (2) consult with relevant persons in the public sector, including
21 but not limited to, officers and employees of the Department of
22 Labor and Workforce Development, with relevant persons in the
23 private sector, including employers of temporary workers and
24 organizations representing temporary workers, and with members of
25 the academic community and of relevant branches of the legal
26 profession;

27 (3) examine the experience of temporary workers in this State;
28 and

29 (4) make other investigations as it may deem necessary in
30 carrying out the purposes of this act.

31 c. The Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development
32 shall within 12 months of the effective date of this act report the
33 findings and conclusions of the study to the Legislature, pursuant to
34 section 2 of P.L.1991, c.164 (C.52:14-19.1), and shall include in the
35 report any recommendations for legislation which the commissioner
36 deems appropriate.

38 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

43 This bill requires the Department of Labor and Workforce
44 Development to undertake a study on the effects of temporary
45 employment on the work force of the State of New Jersey. The
46 study is to consider the comprehensive effects of temporary
47 employment, and shall include, but not be limited to, the effects of
