Requires DOLWD to undertake study on effects of temporary employment on work force.

**CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT**

1 temporary employment on wages, businesses, and workers  
2 throughout the State.

3 The bill requires the department, in conducting the study, to:

4 (1) consider federal and State laws relating directly or indirectly  
5 to temporary help service firms and employment agencies;

6 (2) consult with relevant persons in the public and private  
7 sectors, and with members of the academic community and of  
8 relevant branches of the legal profession;

9 (3) examine the experience of temporary workers in this State;  
10 and

11 (4) make other investigations as it may deem necessary.

12 The bill requires the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce  
13 Development to report the findings and conclusions of the study to  
14 the Legislature within 12 months of the bill's effective date and to  
15 include in the report any recommendations for legislation which the  
16 commissioner deems appropriate.
