SYNOPSIS

Requires clinic connected with dental school at public institution of higher education to give priority to 100 percent disabled veterans.

1	AN ACT concerning dental care for veterans and supplementing
2	chapter 3 of Title 38A of the New Jersey Statutes.

4	BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5	of New Jersey:

7	1. A clinic that is part of the extramural network of dental
8	clinics established by the Rutgers School of Dental Medicine, or by
9	any other dental school of a public institution of higher education,
10	shall give priority to any 100 percent disabled veteran seeking oral
11	health services, when scheduling appointments at the dental clinic.
12	As used in this section, "100 percent disabled veteran" means any
13	citizen and resident of this State honorably discharged or released
14	under honorable circumstances from active service in any branch of
15	the Armed Forces of the United States who is adjudicated by the
16	United States Department of Veterans Affairs, or its successor, as
17	being permanently 100 percent disabled.
18	In giving priority to a 100 percent disabled veteran, a dental
19	clinic shall ensure that an oral health treatment appointment for the
20	veteran is scheduled in a timely manner and that the time between
21	the scheduling of the appointment and the occurrence of the
22	appointment does not exceed 30 days.

24	2. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, in
25	consultation with the Department of Health, shall adopt pursuant to
26	the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1
2728	et seq.), rules and regulations necessary to effectuate the purposes of this act.

33	STATEMENT

35	This bill requires a clinic that is part of the extramural network
36	of dental clinics established by the Rutgers School of Dental
37	Medicine, or by any other dental school of a public institution of
38	higher education, to give priority to 100 percent disabled veterans
39	in scheduling appointments at the dental clinic.
40	In giving priority to a 100 percent disabled veteran, a dental
41	clinic is required to ensure that an oral health treatment appointment
42	for the veteran is scheduled in a timely manner and that the time
43	between the scheduling of the medical appointment and the

occurrence of the appointment does not exceed 30 days.
