SYNOPSIS

Prohibits public institutions of higher education from increasing resident undergraduate tuition by more than two percent over prior academic year.

1 AN ACT concerning tuition rates at public institutions of higher
2 education and supplementing chapter 62 of Title 18A of the New
3 Jersey Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law, rule, or
9 regulation to the contrary, a public institution of higher education
10 shall not increase the institution's resident undergraduate tuition
11 rates for any academic year by more than two percent over the
12 institution's resident undergraduate tuition rates for the prior
13 academic year.

15 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall first apply to
16 the first full academic year following the date of enactment.

STATEMENT

21 This bill prohibits a public institution of higher education from
22 increasing the institution's resident undergraduate tuition rates for
23 any academic year by more than two percent over the institution's
24 resident undergraduate tuition rates for the prior academic year.
