**SYNOPSIS**

Requires health insurance carriers to reimburse health care providers for vaccines at rate no less than CDC cost per dose rate.

**CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT**

As introduced.



1 AN ACT concerning reimbursement for health care providers and  
2 supplementing P.L.1997, c.192 (C.26:2S-1 et seq.).

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4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
5 of New Jersey:

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7 1. A carrier shall reimburse a health care provider that provides  
8 a vaccine at a rate that is no less than the vaccine's Centers for  
9 Disease Control and Prevention cost per dose rate pursuant to the  
10 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention vaccine price list. The  
11 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention cost per dose rate shall  
12 be the rate in effect on the date the vaccine was provided by the health  
13 care provider.

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15 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the 13th month  
16 next following enactment and shall apply to contracts entered into or  
17 renewed after that date.

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STATEMENT

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22 This bill requires health insurance carriers (including insurance  
23 companies, health, hospital, and medical service corporations, and  
24 health maintenance organizations) to reimburse a health care  
25 provider that provides a vaccine at a rate that is no less than the  
26 vaccine's Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) cost per  
27 dose rate pursuant to the CDC vaccine price list. The CDC cost per  
28 dose rate is to be the rate in effect on the date the vaccine was  
29 provided.

30 The CDC vaccine price list provides the CDC and private sector  
31 cost per dose contract prices for vaccines.
